Step 1: Review - Photographing Silverware Presentation

For today's assignment I want you to photograph utensils from your kitchen, and utilizing a mini studio, shoot spoons, knives and or forks, both vertically and horizontally. You will do this with 8-10 times both vertically and horizontally and create a big collage with your side by side comparisons. Please edit all your images before you put them onto a collage, so your images look cohesive. I also want to see your very best shot!

When you are taking these pictures, try to take really nice pictures. Just don't stick a fork on the counter in front of your camera. Be creative. Look at all angles of the fork, shoot from below, stand on a chair and look down. Look at how shadows are created when you incorporate a flashlight.

What you are turning in:

- In the first collage, I want to see your best 10 horizontal shots.
- In the second collage, I want to see your best 10 vertical shots.
