The father of Photograms is Man Ray. You can [watch this slideshow](#) of images to get inspired and become more familiar with his work.

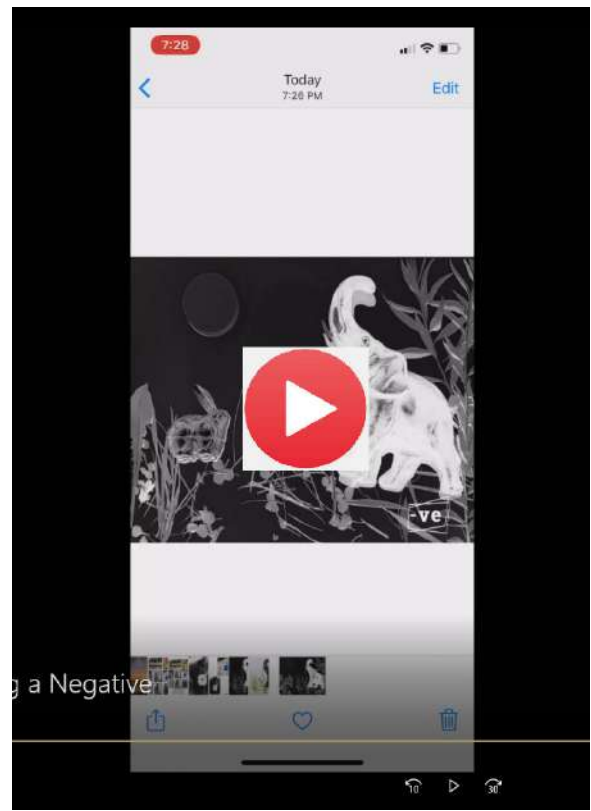
Using a sheet of white paper and small found objects to create a story. You will convert your photo to a negative on the free app called Negative, and save your photo. Then open up your new negative image and create a high contrast black and white edit or use the Noir filter on your iPhone's in camera editing app.

Do a few different stories to get the best result. Review all your work and turn in which one you think is your best and write a few sentences about the story behind your picture.
