You will write a DBQ essay in response to this prompt.

To be considered for extra credit points **you must turn in** (all hand-written):

1. Planning

- a. Show that you went through ALL OF THE steps of a DBQ
- b. Need a reminder of the steps? (LOOK BELOW)

2. Essay

- a. Be sure you follow the set up of an essay (the second page of this handout includes a set up)
- b. Write an actual essay (not an outline or in the boxes in the second page of this)
- c. Be sure to use the documents correctly (give me the "dig deeper", NOT THE ATA!!); and cite them correctly (Doc. G)
- d. NO QUOTES!

****If you are unsure about any of this process- YOU NEED TO COME SEE ME DURING TUTORIALS OR HAWK TIME. This is a great opportunity for you to make up points, but also to improve your DBQ writing skills- take advantage of it!!****

STEPS TO WRITE A DBQ:

1. Read and understand the prompt
2. Brainstorm OUTSIDE INFORMATION that you could use to respond to the prompt
3. ORGANIZE that information into CATEGORIES (this could be GPERSIA, or other categories)- REMEMBER your categories are THE PARAGRAPHS in your essay!
4. Create a working (so it's not quite perfect, yet) **thesis** (do the three!!) statement
5. Examine the documents (be thinking about the prompt and your categories as you do this!)
6. Place the documents within the categories that you created in step 3!
7. WRITE YOUR ESSAY!!

Thesis Statement- remember it must have the 3! (AP, TAKE A STANCE, SET UP THE ESSAY(what will you talk about in each paragraph? Ties to your topic sentences!!))
