In addition to formal admission into UNCG, priority will be given to prospective students that meet the following criteria:

North Carolina residency

Major in Elementary, Middle Grades, High School, or Special Education

3.80 weighted cumulative high school GPA

1170 SAT (verbal and math) or 24 ACT composite score

Responses to additional essay questions on the program application

The program is now accepting applications. Priority will be given to those that apply by January 1.

A new cohort begins in the fall.
