Drexel R-IV Board of Education Board Meeting Media Summary December 2023

- 1. Board approved the consent agenda, which included the minutes of the November 6th special meeting and the November 20th regular meeting, warrant report, payment of bills, treasurer's report and petty cash report. The board approved a high school football cooperative agreement with Miami for 2024. The board approved removing Sydney Shipps as a banking signatory and approved adding Sheila Eastwood as a banking signatory. The board also heard administrative reports (attached).
- 2. Under Old Business:
 - a. Approved the 2024-2025 School Calendar.
- 3. Under New Business:
 - a. Approved a request from the Senior Class to take a Senior Trip to Branson, Missouri on April 20-22, 2024.
- 4. The board held an executive session, taking the following action:
 - a. Accepted the retirement/resignation of Doug Chisam as K-12 Assistant Principal effective at the end of the 2023-2024 school year.
 - b. Accepted the resignation of Britanni Nichols as a special education paraprofessional effective December 31, 2023.
 - c. Approved a recommendation to transfer Lacey Wheeler to part-time food services clerk and part-time Title One paraprofessional.
 - d. Approved a recommendation to hire Gary Griffin as junior high/high school assistant track coach for the Spring 2024 season.

Terry Mayfield Superintendent ➤ Board Candidate Filing – candidate filing for the April 2, 2024 general election is open. Filing will end on December 26th, 2023 at 5:00 PM. There are two positions available with three-year terms. The terms of Brenda Hadley and Lynn Stark are expiring. As of December 13th, 2023, the following individuals have officially filed; Jared Jacobs and Brian Faulkner.

Operations Updates:

- o Facilities/Maintenance
 - Working with Pro-Alliance on the work list of projects to be completed over the break.
 - They plan on replacing the sink faucets over the break and those will be retested as a part of our remediation plan for the lead in water legislation.
 - We have had to replace compressors on two of the Daikin units in the last two months.
 - McKinstry will be on-site in January to conduct additional walk throughs and work on getting better cost estimates for our projects that would be financed with passage of the \$1,950,000 general obligation bond issue in April.
- o Food Service November
 - 2,314 breakfast served
 - 145/day
 - 53% of students eat school breakfast daily
 - 2,656 lunches served
 - 166/day
 - 60% of students eat school lunch daily
- Health Services
 - November office visits 497 with 22 students sent home.
 - Nurse Darrah is finishing up required CPR training for the senior class.
 - Nurse Darrah is also continuing to update health manuals and developing a policy and procedure manual for the health office.
- o Technology
 - The district has applied for additional E-Rate Category 2 funding for additional access points, switches and battery back-ups. We have just a little over \$22,000 in funding that we are eligible to receive. In the next few weeks we will be getting quotes back from vendors and taking time to evaluate the responses. We are also eligible to receive about a 40% 45% discount on our internet service provider (MOREnet) through E-Rate Category 1 funding, to which we have applied for as well. This could provide an additional \$8,000 to \$10,000 in savings.
- o Transportation
 - Several of the area superintendents met recently to discuss the possibility of creating a student transportation consortium. Drexel currently has one

more year on the original Apple Bus contract that First Student has assumed. So, our last year is 2024-2025 and at that time the district will have to go out for bid once again. I would like for the board to start thinking if we want to go through this process again this year, or do we wait and see if the new company gets up and running with a few local schools and then go through the bid process after the 24-25 school year. I do believe that if there is a startup company that there will be a handful of schools that make the move now. Again, the biggest concern will be can they get enough buses to build a fleet and can they recruit and hire enough drivers.
