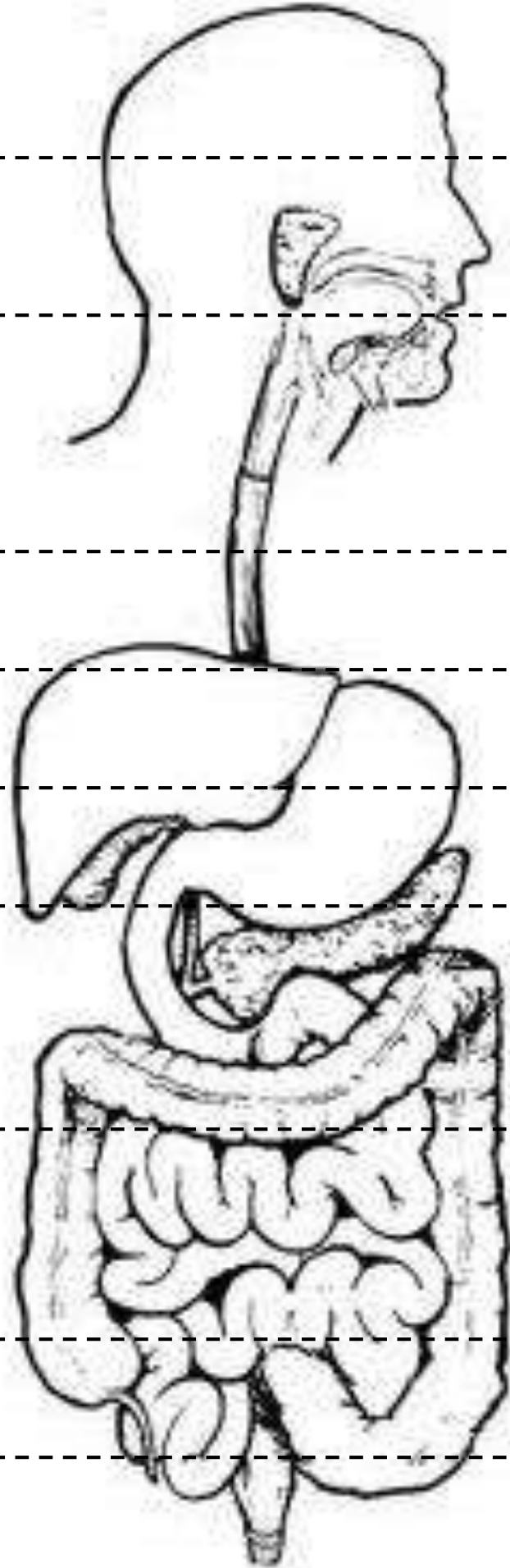
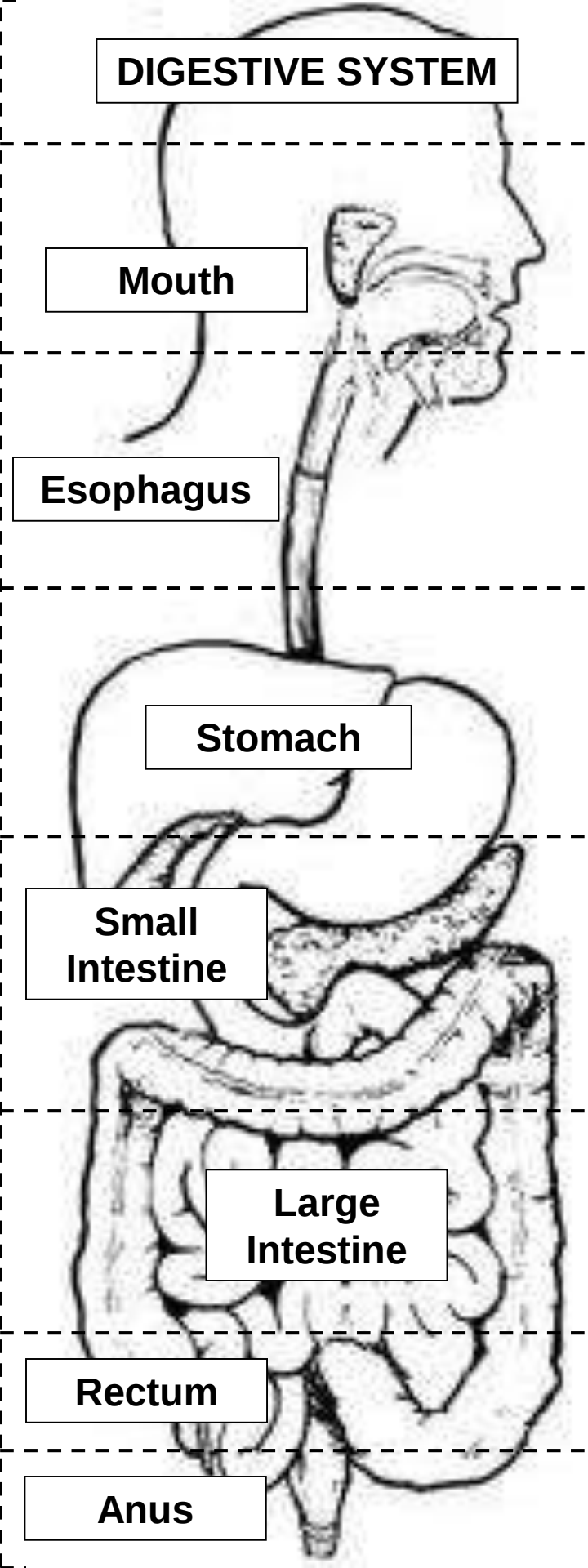




DIGESTIVE SYSTEM
