

## **Digestive System Foldable**

Students will create a Digestive System foldable that demonstrates the objectives outlined below. The foldable must contain all pertinent information and will be designed so they are legible and useful in studying. The foldable will be graded on word choice, organization, and accuracy.

Step 1: Get a piece of paper and fold the ends together so that the edges meet in the middle



Step 2: Make cuts in the flaps so that you have 8 equal flaps.




Step 3: Label the outside of the flaps:

- 1. Mouth & 2 types of Digestion
- 2. Esophagus and movement
- 3. Stomach- type of acid, 3 parts, and rugae
  - 4. 3 sections of small intestine
- 5. Large Intestine Functions
- 6. 6 sections of Lg. Intestine
- 7. Elimination of waste
- 8. Accessory organs and their functions

Step 4: On the inside of the corresponding flap you will write the answers based on what we discussed from your notes and you may also use the book. Be thorough with your answers.

Step 5: On the inside of your foldable you will glue the diagram (provided by teacher) in the center.



Step 6: Label the diagram.

Step 7: On the back of the foldable, give:

- 1. The functions of the Digestive System
- 2. Define Deglutition, Mastication, and Sphincter. Add these to your diagram in red.
- 3. Write the function of the villi and draw a picture.

<sup>\*</sup>include vocabulary we have discussed such as teeth, tongue, fundus, bile, insulin, anus, feces, etc.

4. Write your name, date, and period on the bottom of the back of the foldable.
