DIGITAL SELFIES IN ADOBE DRAW

- **1. FIND A PHOTO**
 - MOST IMPORTANT: Have light, medium, and dark areas in the face.
 - Have emotion, props, action, story, or something to make the face interesting.





2. CROPPING

- Crop out unwanted parts. You want mostly the face with maybe a bit more.
- You can see that I've cropped out my cheese-ball friend...because I am soooo pretty! ^(C)

GET PAINTING!

- Watch the video to set up Adobe Draw.
- You NEED dark, light, and medium layers!
- Try to think of areas of your face as either dark, light, or medium.
- DON'T outline, or just color in shapes, like your nose!

1. PAINT YOUR DARKS

- Paint dark AREAS with your dark color, on your dark layer.
- DON'T color areas solid.
- DO color a bit behind hair and eyebrows.

TURN IN ON GOOGLE CLASSROOM BEFORE GOING FURTHER! I'll probably return it a few times before it's right. That's why this step is worth more points.





2. PAINT YOUR LIGHTS

- Turn off your DARK LAYER.
- Paint ON your LIGHT LAYER
- Paint all of your lightest areas, leave the medium areas alone.
- Just like your Dark Layer, DON'T paint things in solid.





3. PAINT YOUR MEDIUMS

- This step is MUCH EASIER. Your mediums should be everything you have left of your face, minus details, hair, and clothing.
- Paint on your MEDIUM LAYER.
- Paint BEHIND your Dark and Light Layers.
- Still, don't go totally solid.
