A diptych is a photograph that uses two different or identical images side by side to form one single artistic statement or a strong relationship between the two subjects.



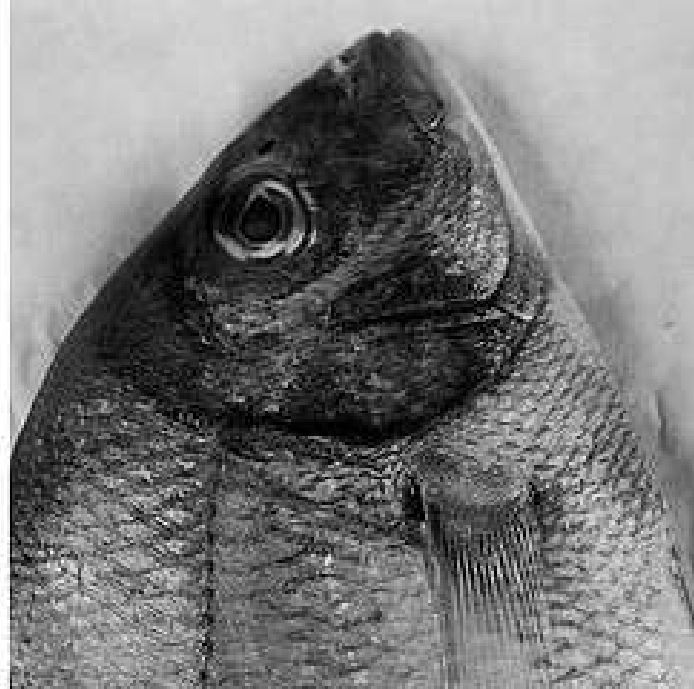


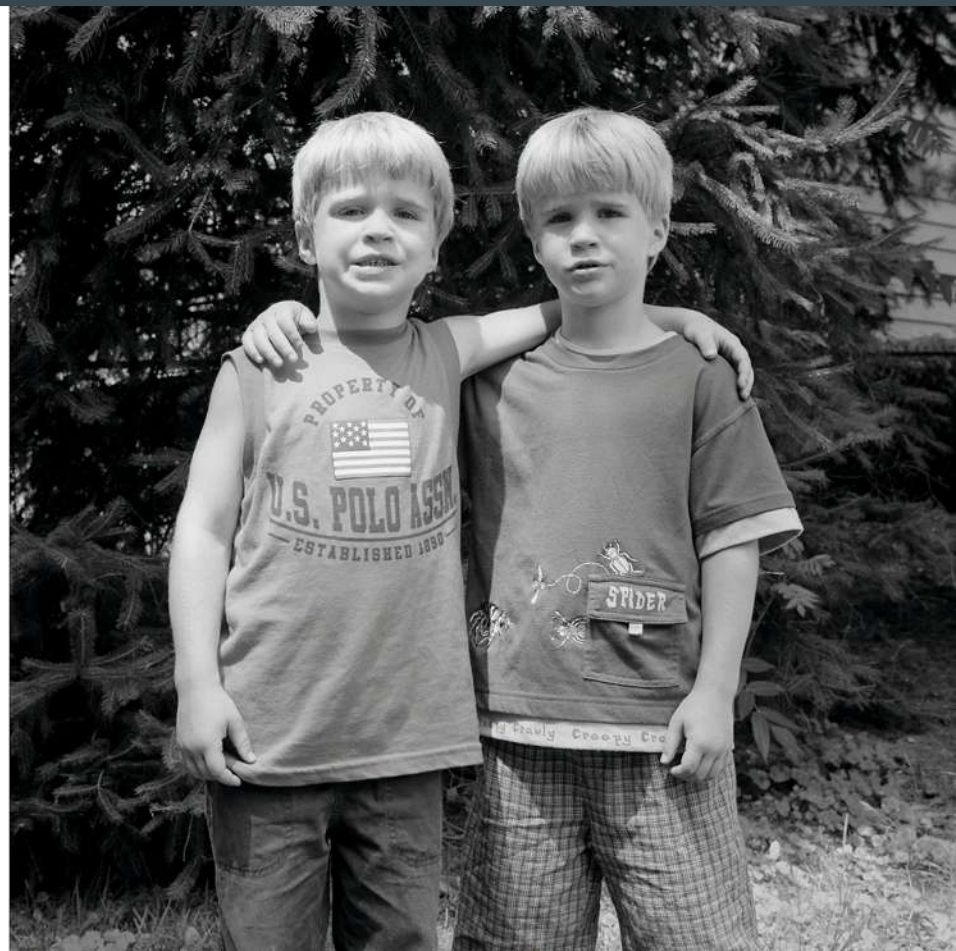
