Disney Parks Expansion Project

Directions: Disney has hired you to lead the expansion of a new theme park, somewhere in the world. It is up to your team to decide the best city/location/country for this new park to open. Some of the required quidelines include:

- 1. It must be outside of the United States
- 2. It cannot be in a country that already has a theme park.

You will design one park, including rides and attractions. You may want to research other theme parks/attractions in the country and see what already exists. You can also use the theme parks here in the U.S. as a quide - but remember to adapt as needed.

You'll create a map, labeled with the attractions and a summary (in whatever format you choose) on the following questions:

- 1. Why did you pick this country/city/location?
- 2. Create a brief cultural profile of the country
 - a. History
 - b. Education systems & literacy rates
 - c. Languages & verbal/nonverbal communication customs
 - d. Major holidays and customs
 - e. Business practices, length of work day, hiring, etc.
- 3. What modifications or eliminations will need to be made to the Park or the "Disney Image"?
- 4. How did you select the attractions and entertainment for this park?
- 5. What type of food/restaurants will be in your park and why?
- 6. How will the Disney "theme" and personality be applied and obvious in your park?
- 7. What transportation options are/will be available to get to and from your park?
- 8. What considerations are there regarding foreign currency/exchange rates?
