Personal contact information is not shared and a message history is available. School Messenger: District administration utilize this call feature to reach parents and guardians about such things as late busses, Parent Teacher Conferences, snow days and school emergencies. Parents may sign up for school messenger at either building office or central office.

Lumen Parent Portal: This online system enables parents to access attendance information, course schedules, grades and lunch account information for students within our district. Parent/Student Portal is a free component of our student information system.

In order to use Parent/Student Portal, the district must have your current email address in our student database. ***Please note: Only parents/guardians who are considered "Educational Decision Makers" can be granted access to the Parent Portal. Federal Privacy Laws (Family Educational Right to Privacy Act - FERPA) prevents us from doing so, and NO EXCEPTIONS can be made to this policy.***
