Parent Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures SY 2023-24

MORNING DROP-OFF	AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Students arriving after 7:15 AM are considered tardy.	George G. Dodge staff will be present outside.

Important Information Regarding Drop-off and Pick-up:

AM Drop-Off

- Parent/Guardian drop-off and pick-up will take place by the front double doors of George G. Dodge Intermediate School.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to enter Dodge’s parking lot slowly (speed limit is **5mph**). Once you enter the main entryway, please turn left at the first intersection. This will allow you to safely enter the parent drop-off area. It is important that you turn right and travel along the grass area so that you can position yourself for the **passenger side, curb drop-off**. *This traffic pattern is the same as the previous school year. Arrows have been painted on the pavement to assist you.*
- **It is important that children are able to operate their seatbelt, open the car door on the passenger side, and handle their backpack/belongings independently.** We appreciate your help in maintaining a safe drop-off routine as you exit slowly through the same drive you entered. Staff will be on hand to help you navigate this process.
- **FOR AFTERNOON PICK-UP:** Parents who plan to pick up their children in the afternoon **must** have a George G. Dodge Intermediate School “pick-up” pass displayed properly and visibly. Each family will be assigned a number that will be used to identify children for the appropriate vehicle. Families may request 1 or 2 passes to put in your vehicles for pick-up. ***Please note: Drivers without a pass will have to park and go to the Welcome Center before children will be released.***

Dear Parents/Guardians of our Dodge Students,

If you plan to pick up your child/children on a regular basis during the 2023-2024 school year, please complete and return this form to George G. Dodge Intermediate School office or your child's homeroom teacher. Only one form per family is necessary. A car tag is only issued to the parent or legal guardian by presenting a valid state id or driver's license. A car tag is never sent home with the student.

The George G. Dodge office staff will create a "pick-up pass" for your vehicle(s) and have it ready by the first time you pick up your child. Each family will be assigned a number that will be used to identify you as you arrive for pick-up at the end of the school day. Your pass will need to be displayed in the car window as you enter our pick-up line.

Drivers without a pass will have to park and go into the Welcome Center before children will be released. Please note: In order for someone other than the legal guardian to pick up a child, they must (1) have a note from the parent/legal guardian with the date of pick-up, (2) be listed on the child's Emergency Contact Form, and (3) present a valid photo ID.
