



Doodles are simple drawings that can have concrete representational meaning, may just be abstract shapes, expressive lines and designs, and/or dreamlike images. Doodle projects are projects you will be creating throughout the semester. You will be working on a doodle project if you finish another project early, forget your project, or need a short break from another project for part of the class period.

Doodle Project



The Doodle Projects REQUIREMENTS are as follows:

1. You will turn in a **MINIMUM** of 2 to 4 **Doodles** per semester.
2. However, if you are quick finishing projects, you may have **MORE THAN 2** per semester.
3. You are working on **ART EVERY** class period.
4. Your doodle **MUST** cover the entire piece of 8.5 x 11 paper or larger.
5. **Do NOT** let more than a quarter (1/4) of the white of the paper show!
6. **INCLUDE** Texture, patterns, and details.
7. You **MAY** include **REAL** or **IMAGINARY** image
8. Black, Grays, and Whites or Colors **MUST** have either **SOLID DARK COLORS** or colors that show a **WIDE RANGE** of **VALUE**.
9. Your composition **MUST** use **INFORMAL BALANCE**: *This means the two sides MUST have equal amounts of interesting images and designs, but not be the exact same; not a mirror image of each other.*
10. **NO** landscapes or scenes! Make more **abstract, expressive, and creative**

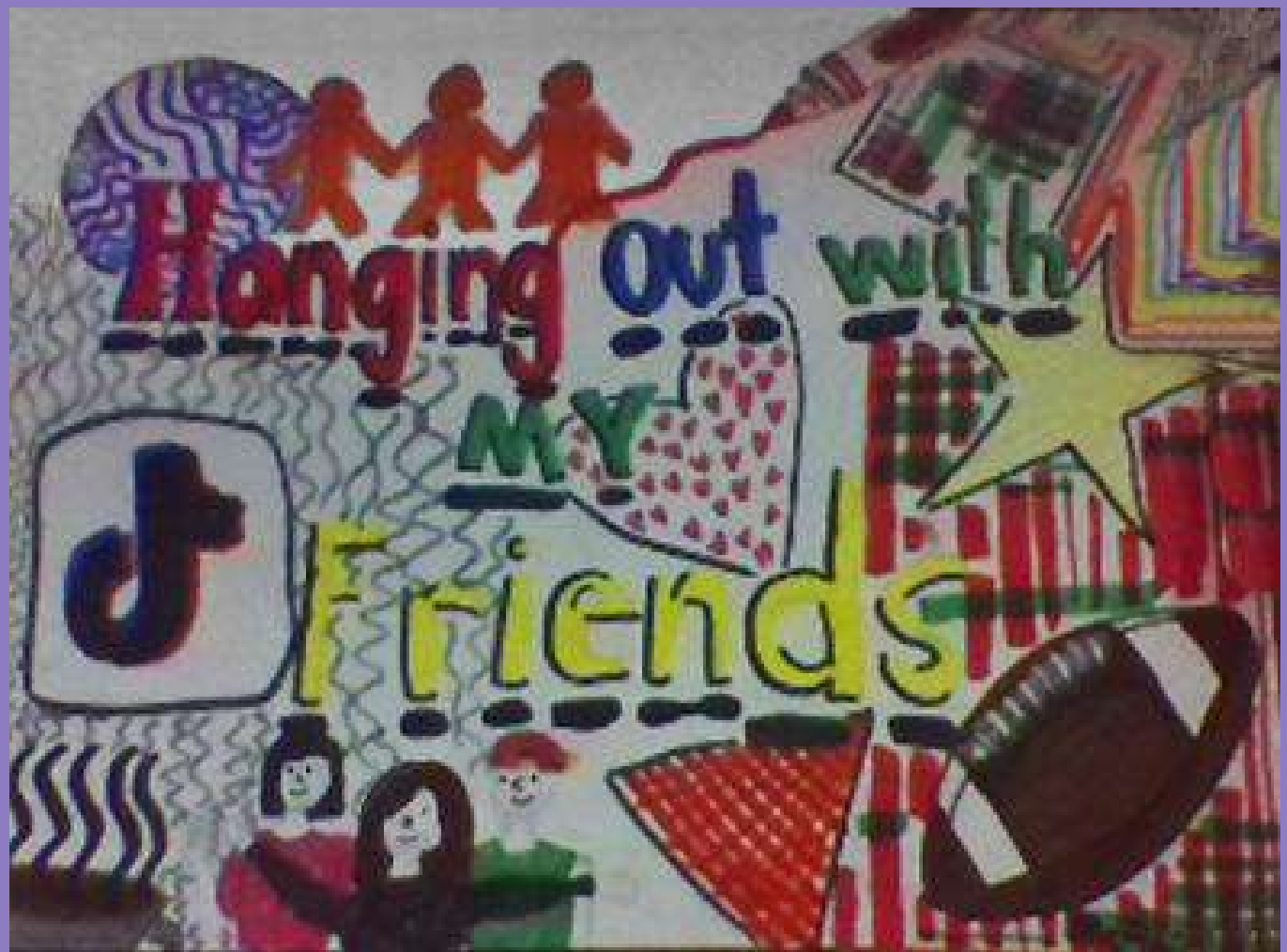

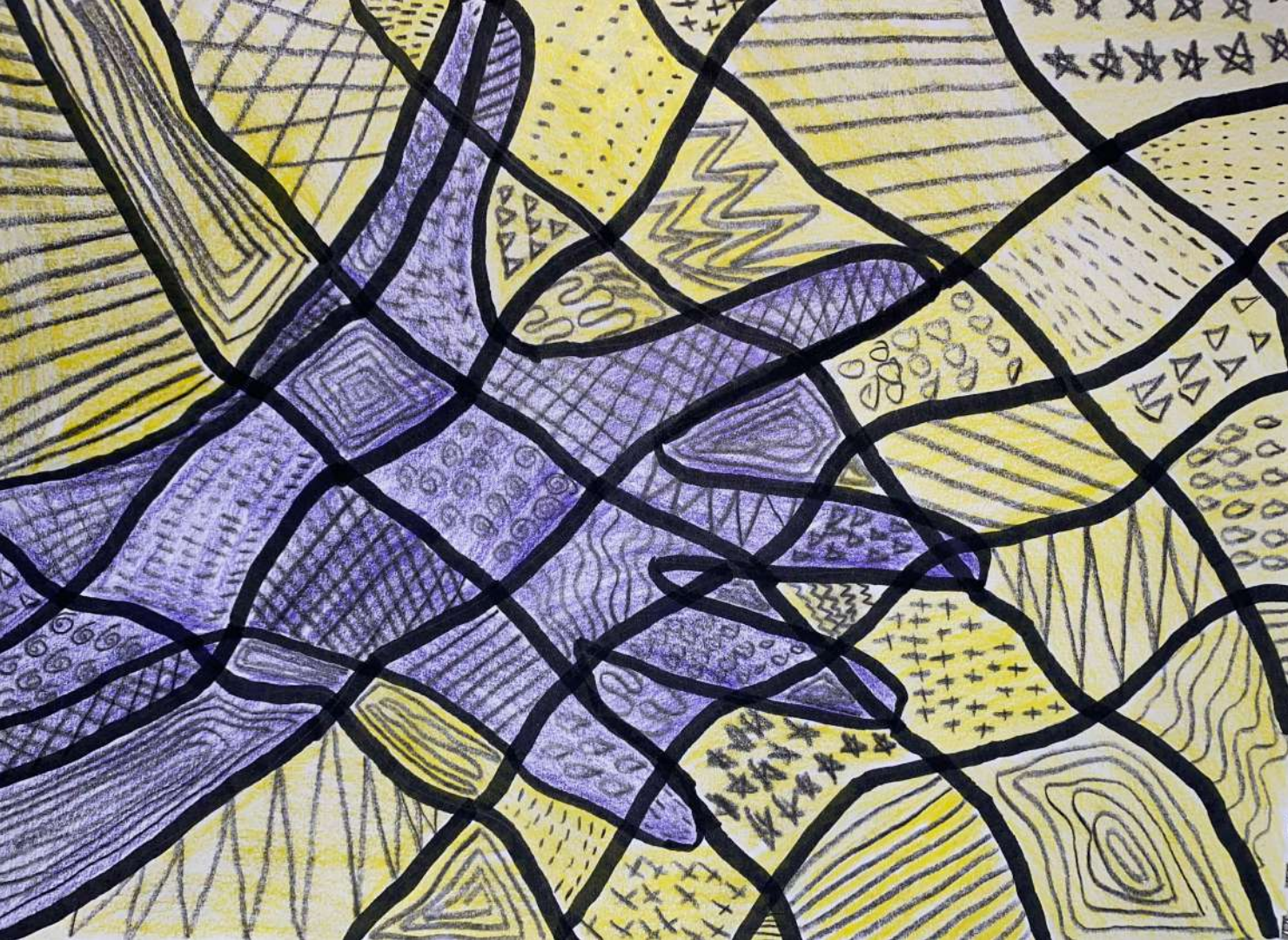
