**Religion:** The belief in a God or a group of Gods.


The king of England did not give the Pilgrims the freedom to practice religion and go to the church they wanted, so they decided to leave.


**fascinated:** Someone is fascinated by something when it holds his/her attention and is interesting.

We joined the Wampanoag during a three day harvest celebration that has come to be known as the first Thanksgiving.






