## Driver's Education Program

Athens Area School District is pleased to be able to offer the Driver's Education Program to students who attend the Athens School District or reside in the Athens School District. To help make this process simple please see the list below as to the responsibility of Parent/Guardian and Student:

- 1. Obtain the Driver's Education Program packet from the High School office.
- 2. Complete the Driver's Education Enrollment Form
- 3. Drop off completed form to the Athens High School office along with the following items:
  - Proof of Residency
  - Copy of Permit (if student does not have it yet, student does need to provide it to the office prior to any driving)
  - Payment made payable to the Athens School District

# After the above (3) steps are completes by Parent/Guardian/Student, listed next is the order of events for Student:

- 1. The student will be enrolled in V-drive by Administration.
- 2. When all of the modules are completed and passed, the student has completed the 30 hours of V-drive time; the student will be contacted by the Driver's Education Secretary and provided with a day and time for the final.
- 3. The final will be scheduled for the student and administered in the Athens High School; students must pass the final before the driving session can begin.
- 4. The Driver Education instructor will notify and designate a driving schedule.
- 5. Student must complete 6 hours of driving, no more than 1 hour/day and it is recommended no more than 1 hour/week. This will provide students an opportunity to practice driving skills with parents outside of school setting. There will also always be at least (2) students in the car at all times.
- 6. Once all driving hours are completed, the Driver's Education Instructor will provide you with an "End of Course" Exam.

Athens Students can register for the Driver's Education course two (2) months prior to his/her sixteenth (16) birthday (graduating students, in order to qualify for the driving program you would have to register for this prior to March  $1^{st}$  of your senior year).

The online course and test must be completed before students can begin driving instruction. It is strongly recommended that you check with your insurance company to see if this course will lower insurance rates. PA DOT does not require a Driver's Education course for permit or licensure.
