## 6. Presentation/Discussion-Presentation on from the CMS Language Arts Curriculum Adoption Committee

**Adoption committee members for CMS: Julie Johansen, Patrick Hartsfield, Kathi Holst, Laura Taylor were on the CMS committee. Julie went through options list of the programs available. Houghton Mifflin Harcourt (6-8) Curriculum was CMS choice. Julie went over the rubric. Live links go to more information about the curriculum. Julie read the CSD Vision and Mission. Julie also went over CMS priorities for ELA Curriculum Adoption. Kathi Holst went over the themes and the connection to CSD Vision and Mission read through the table that was in the presentation. Kathi went over the theme of Engagement and how it hooks the learner and sparks their interest. Engaging examples Vocabulary is huge in this curriculum. Vocabulary is repetitive and is used throughout the curriculum. Pretest the words, use it in the lesson, and assess at the end of the lesson. Academic and vocabulary specific to the story. Patrick Hartsfield talked about the theme of writing. Provides a lot of variety styles: argument, informational, and narrative. Lots of writing graphic organizers to help students build the skills. Note taking is a skill that is taught. This curriculum teaches note taking. Multi-tiered supports to help students. Students come in at different skill**

levels. Audio is available to help struggling students. There is also support for students who need additional rigor because they are above grade level. Laura Taylor went over the assessments: there are many formative assessments and summative assessments. Online assessments that are editable available. Assessments modeled after state assessments and SATs. Assessment and standard reports to make sure state standards are being covered and which standards students need help in. User/Learner Friendly for students and teachers. Pacing guide-realistic and allows customize. The online piece easily links to Google Classroom. Current event options and help you to integrate novels. Teacher manuals and a teacher's corner online for help. Separate Grammar book and practice. Connects with the anchor text. 8. Discussion-Presentation of I-Ready Math Benchmark Data

Julie Johansen shared math diagnostic growth data results. 80% of annual typical growth - so we are ahead of where we should be at this time of year. To start 30% of students tested 3 or more grade levels below which has gone down to 20%. To start 15% of students tested 2 grade level below went to 11%. See attached for more information that was presented. Julie shared is proud of math teachers and intervention teachers. Students are filling in the gaps that were created during Covid.
