K-2 Week Two Lesson

District Focus:

CREATING & EXPLORING Students will generate and refine artistic ideas and artwork while learning to reach beyond their capacities, to explore playfully, and to embrace the opportunity to learn from mistakes.

ALL LESSONS ARE 20 MINS PER DAY:

Lessons are broken up into five 20 minute sessions. Students may complete the project in one sitting, or break it up each day



Objectives:

- I can draw my favorite person and where their favorite place is.
- I can **brainstorm** and ask my favorite person questions about their favorite place.




Monday:

Brainstorm the drawing of your favorite person.

Talk to your person about their favorite place.

Stuck? Look up pictures or cut pictures out of magazines for inspiration



Tuesday:

Draw your favorite person with materials you have at home.

Add lines and details.

Helpful Questions:

What does your person wear?



Wednesday:

Maybe their Favorite place is hiking in the woods?



Or MAYBE! Their bed is their favorite place? Cozy!



Draw your favorite person's favorite place in the **background**.

Helpful Questions:

Is their favorite place a beach in Sao Paulo? What does the sky look like?



Thursday:

Time to color! Fix those lines and add the finishing touches.

Helpful Questions:

What can you add?
Can you fill in any white spots?







Add the final color and find someone in your house to **discuss** about your favorite person and their favorite place.

Helpful Questions:

What is your favorite part?
What part was tricky?
What made you most proud of this?
