

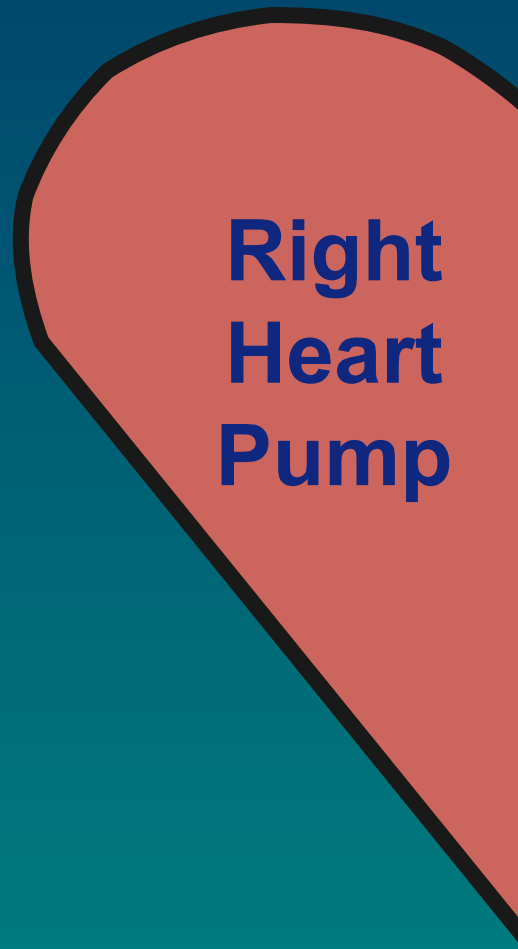

Pathway of Blood Through Heart

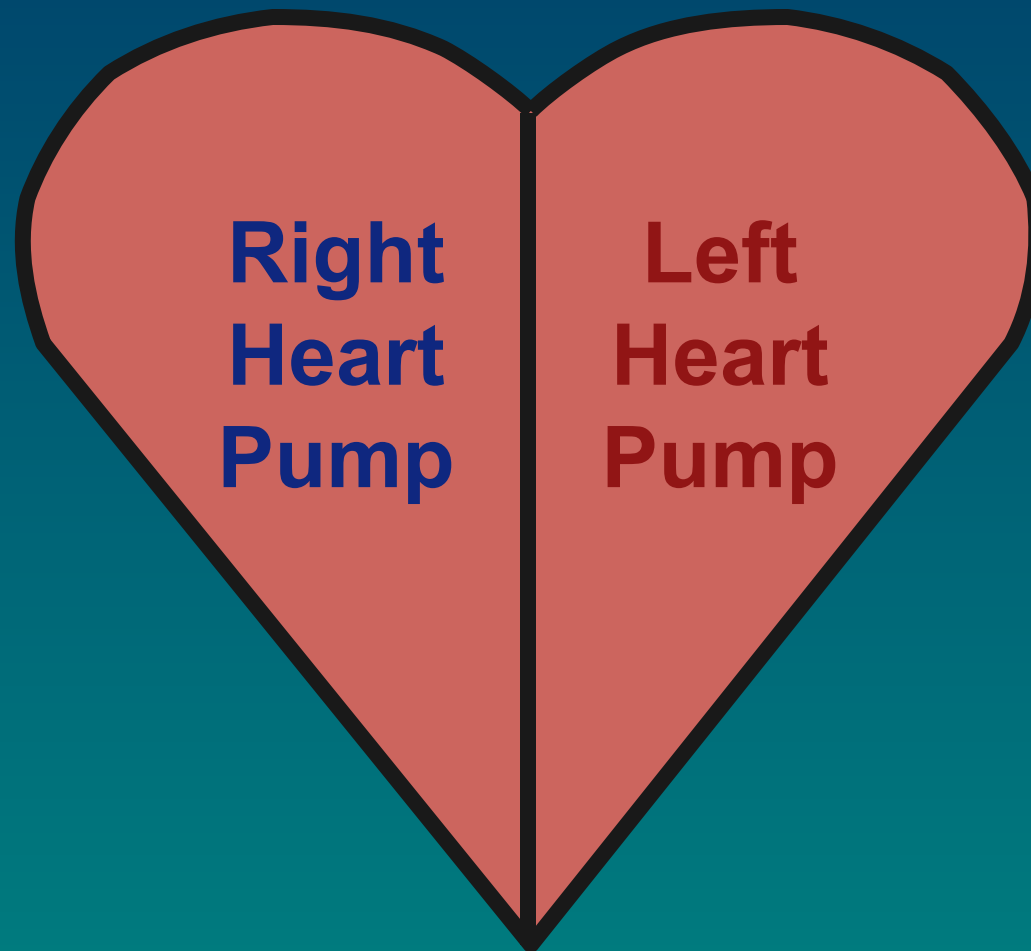
Supplies:

- Optional: highlighter (pink or orange)

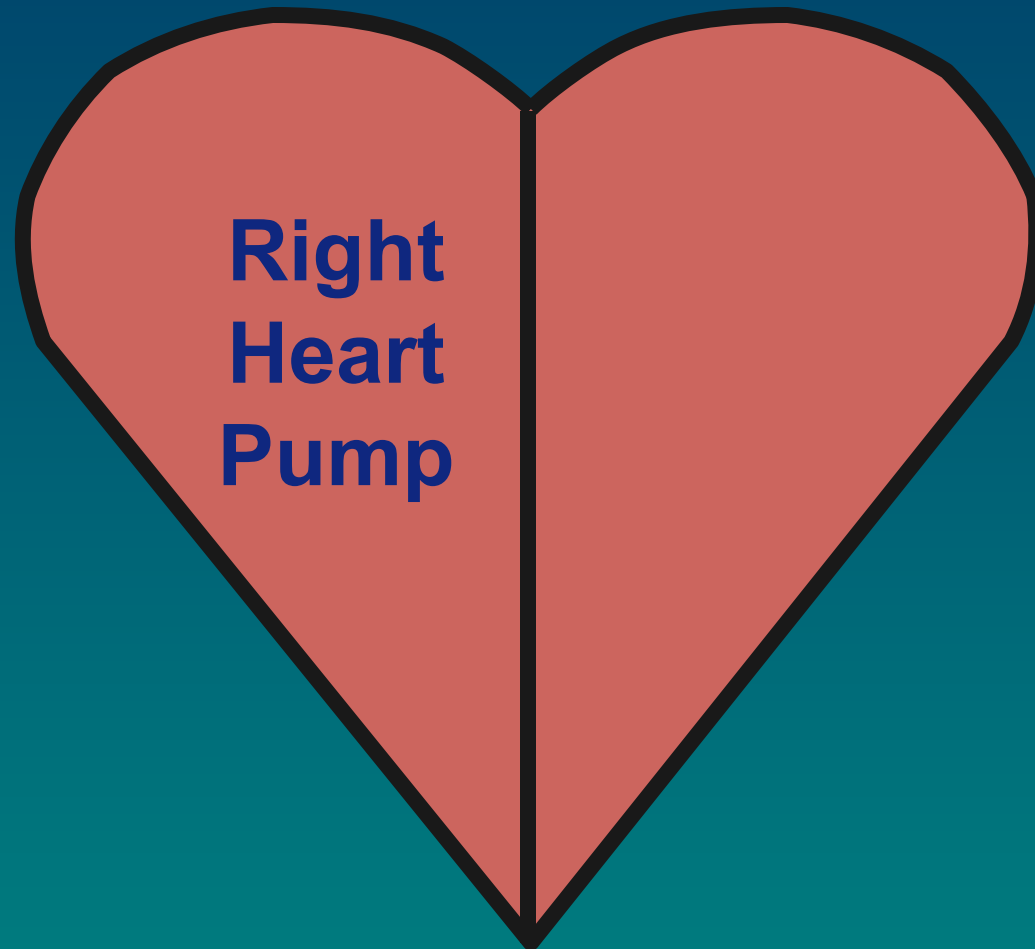
The heart is a double pump.



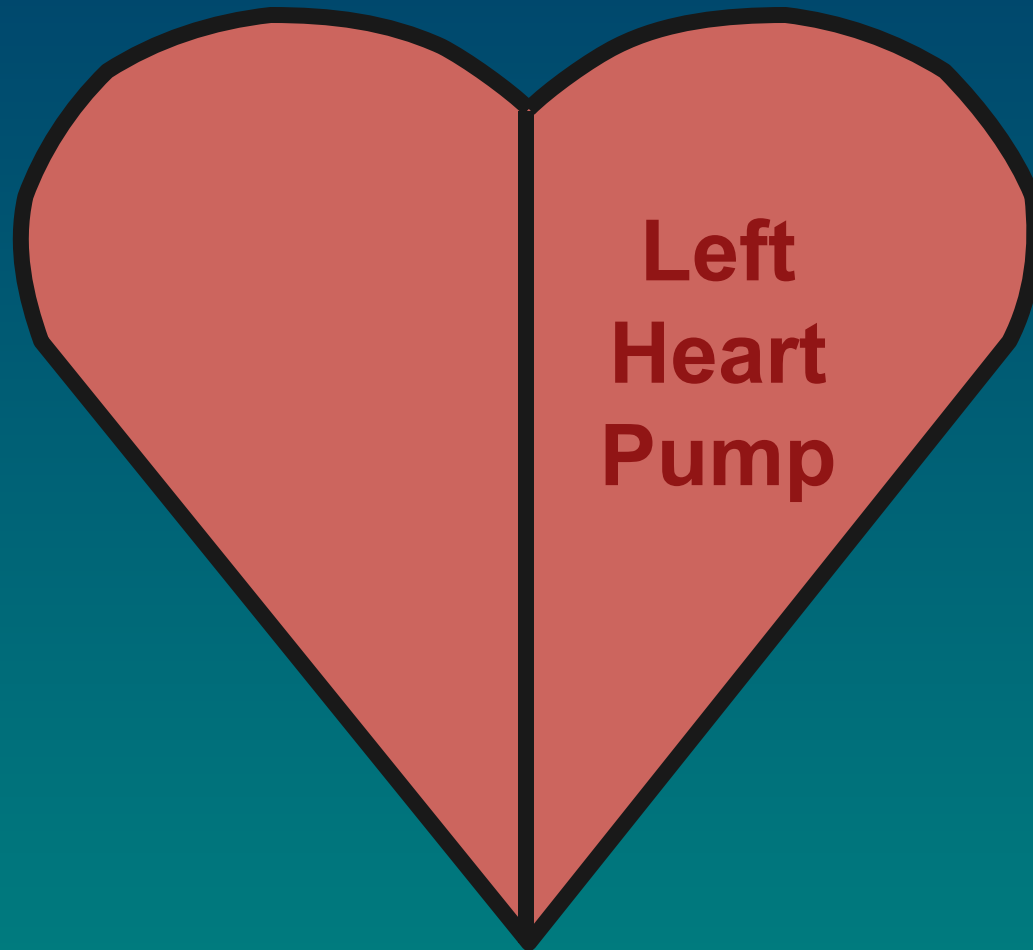
The heart is a double pump.

Drawing the right heart.

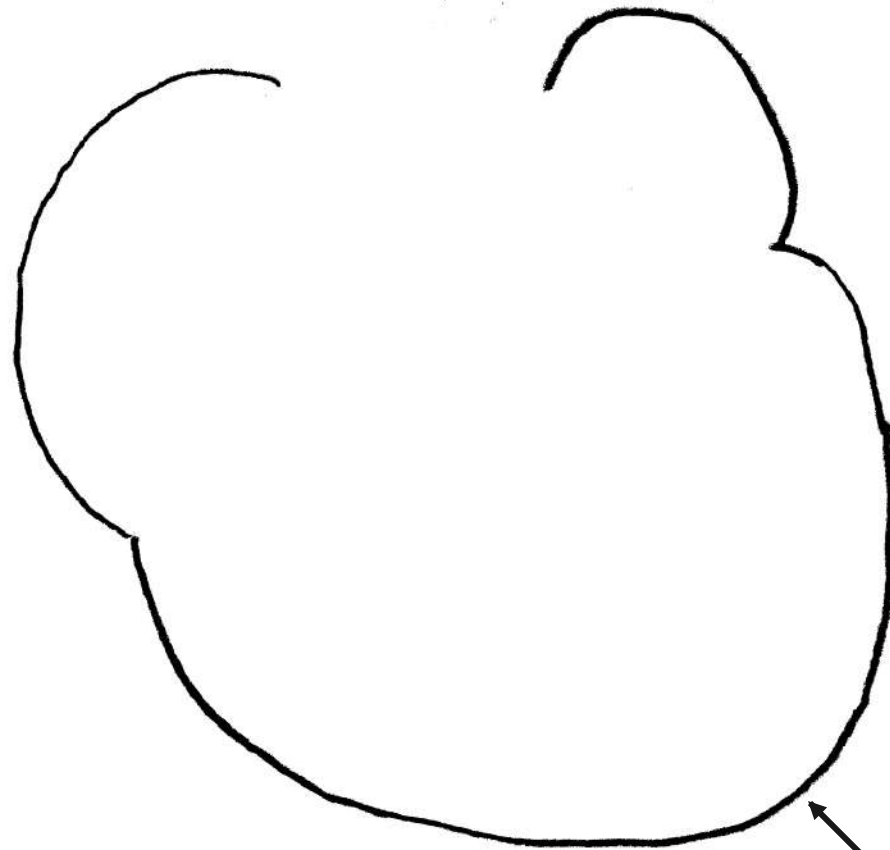

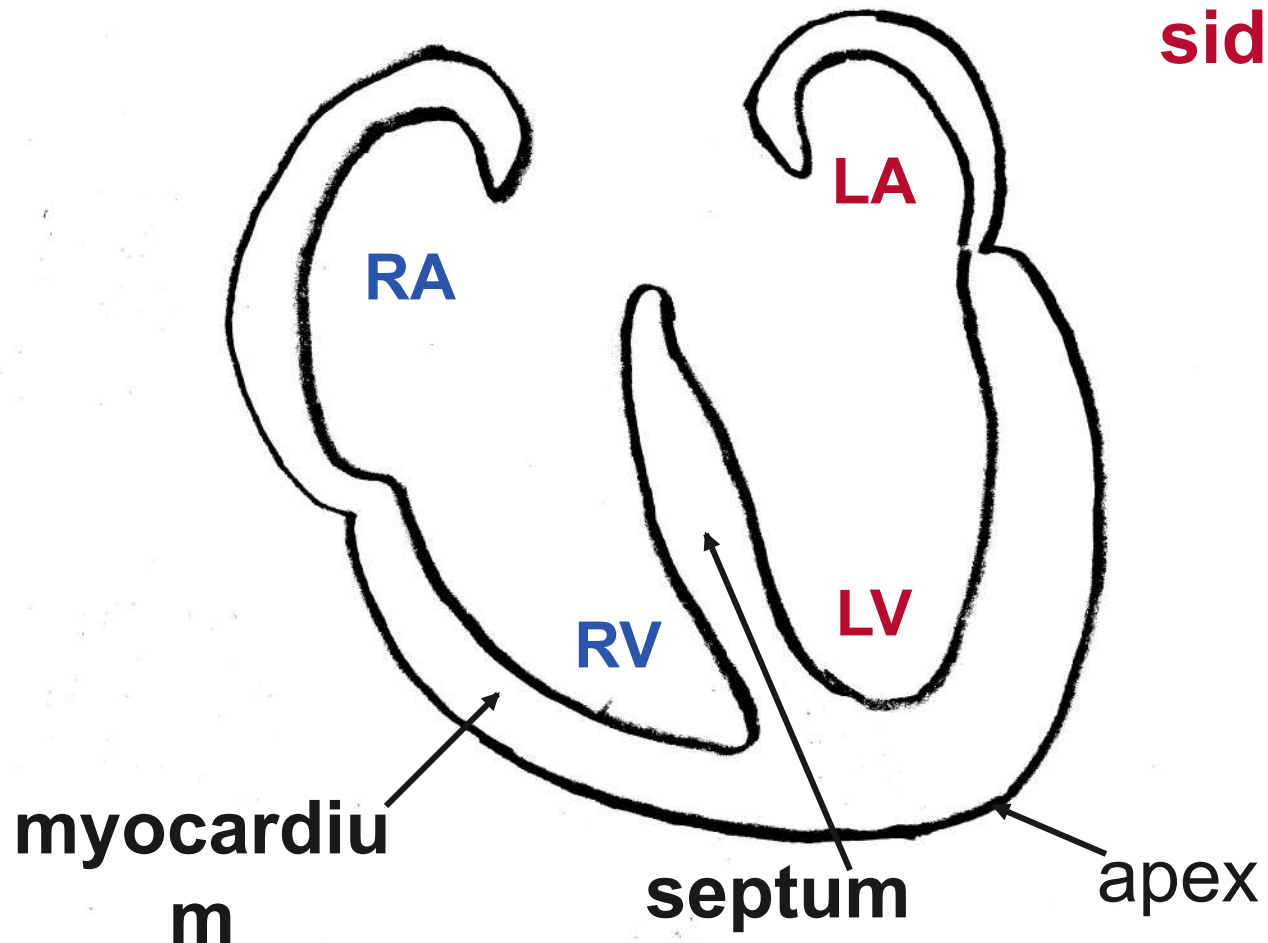

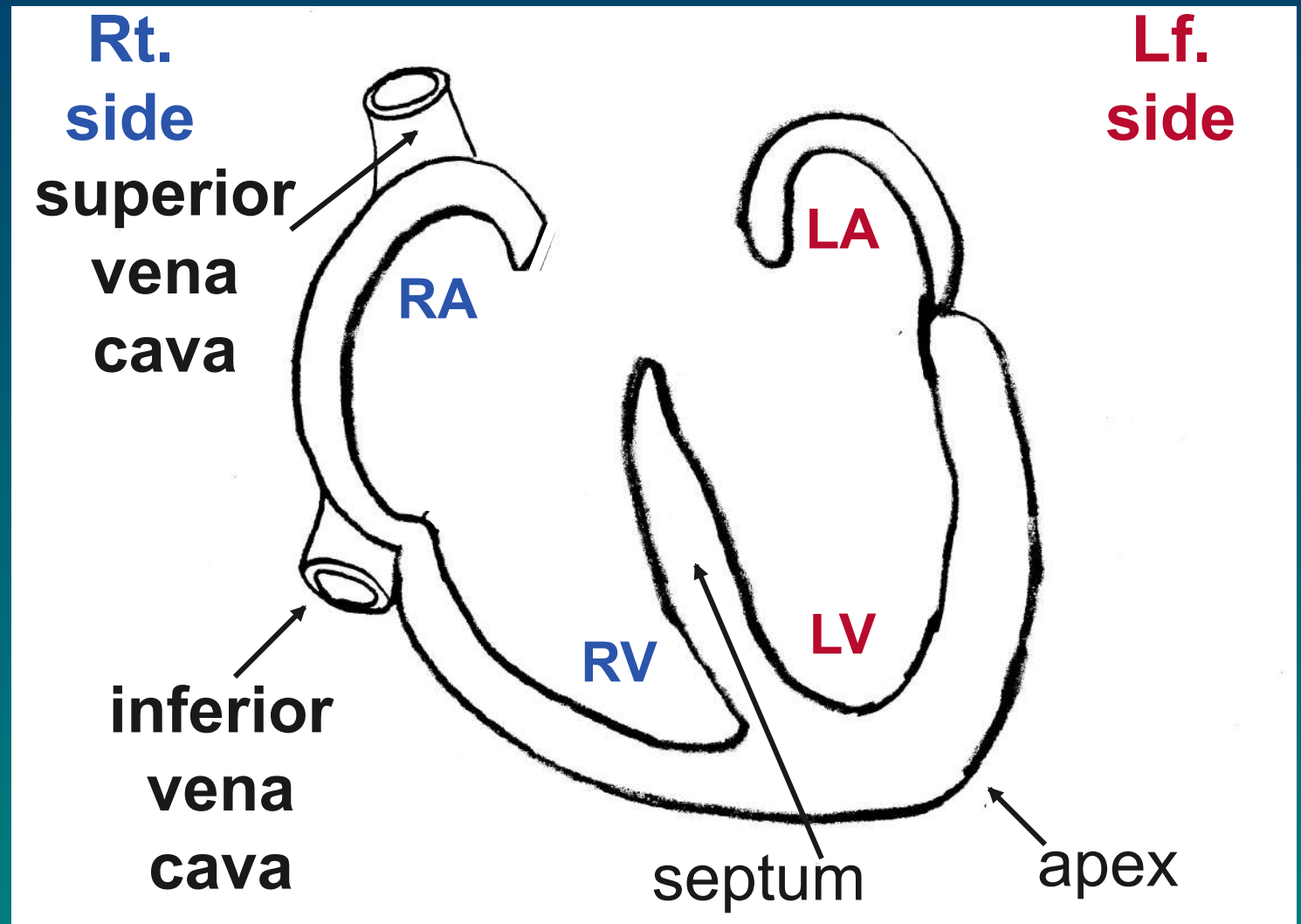
Step 2: Draw myocardium & septum. Identify chambers.

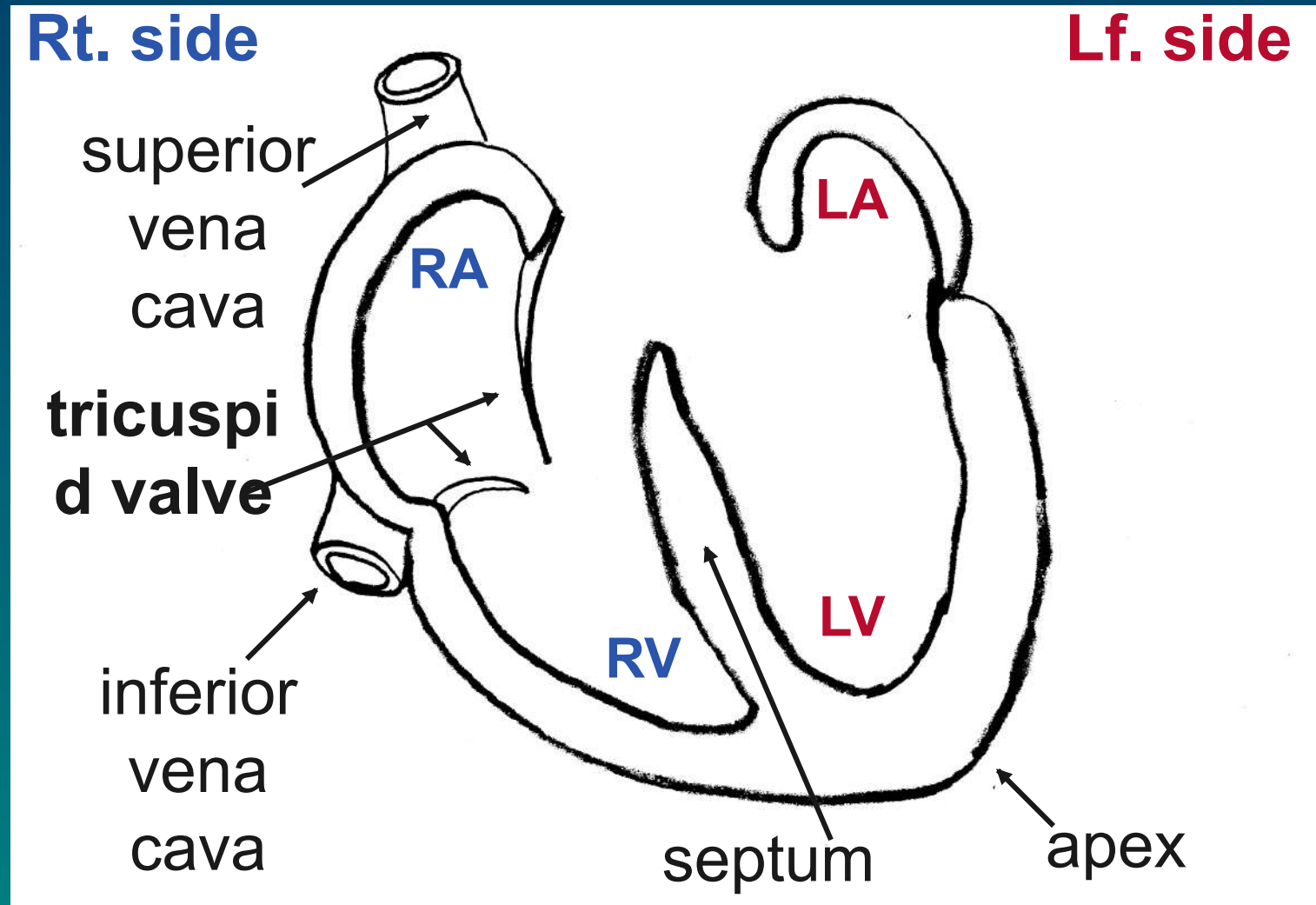

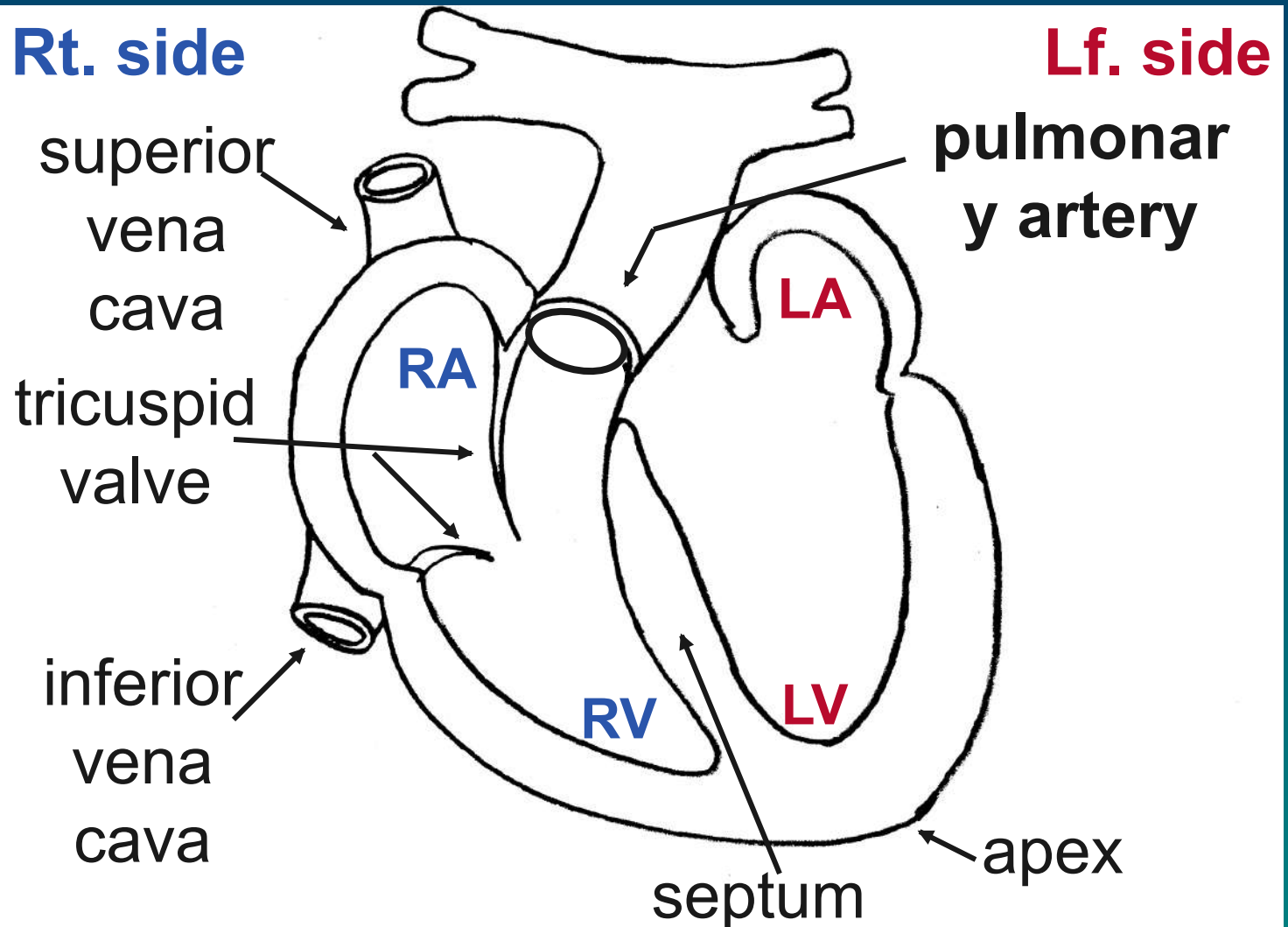
Step 3: Draw both superior & inferior vena cavae



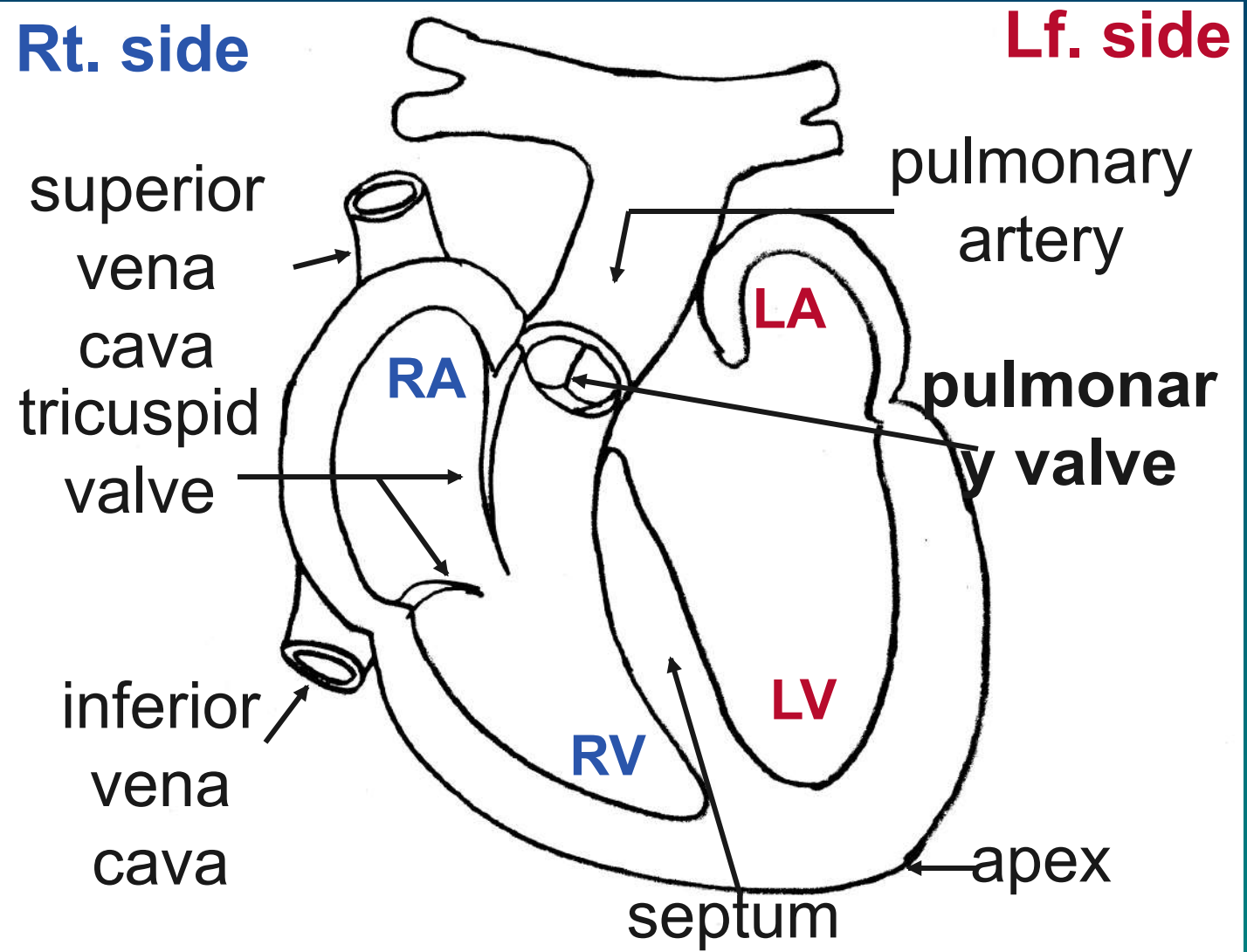
Step 4: Draw tricuspid valve.



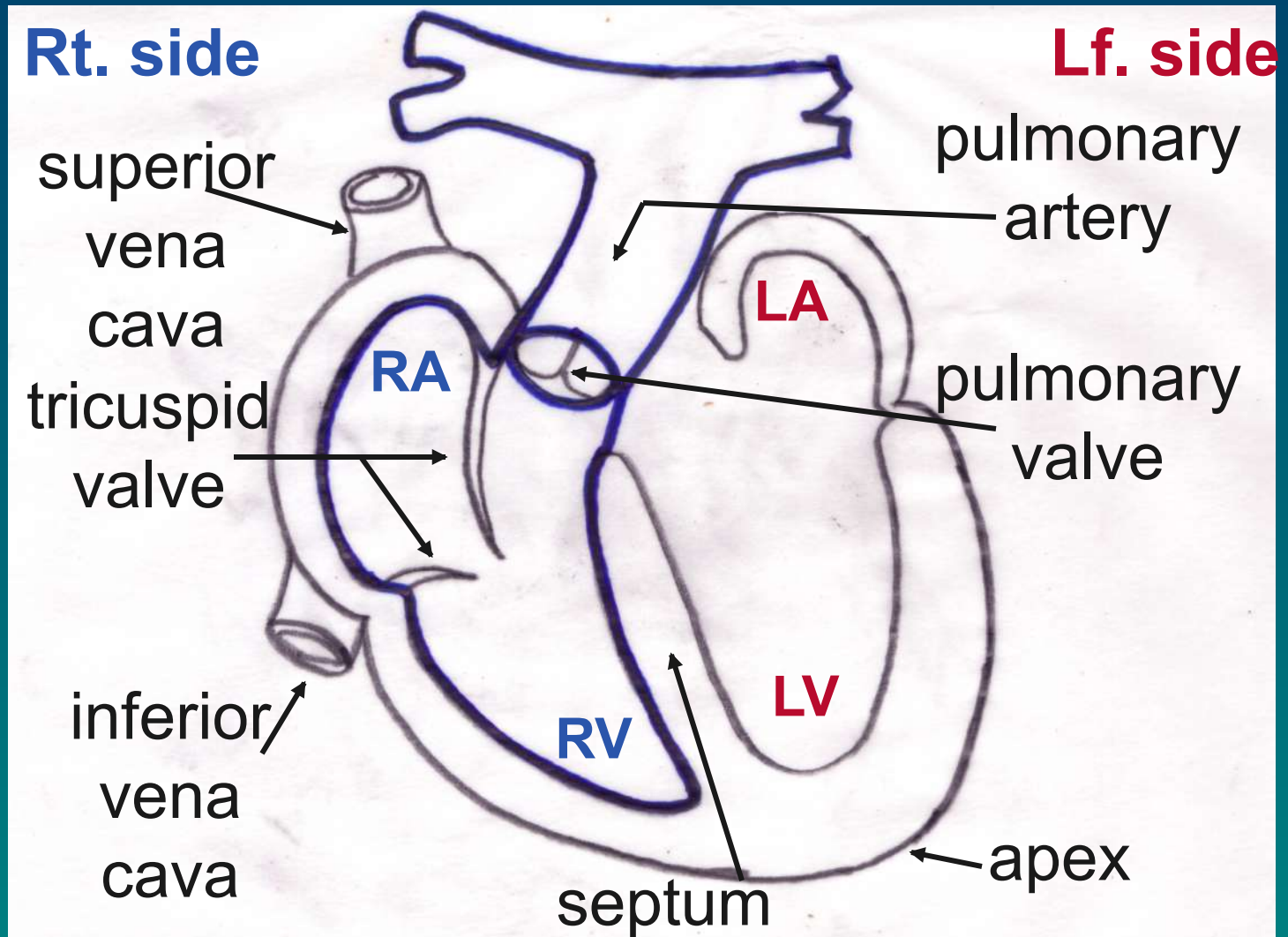
Step 5: Draw pulmonary artery.



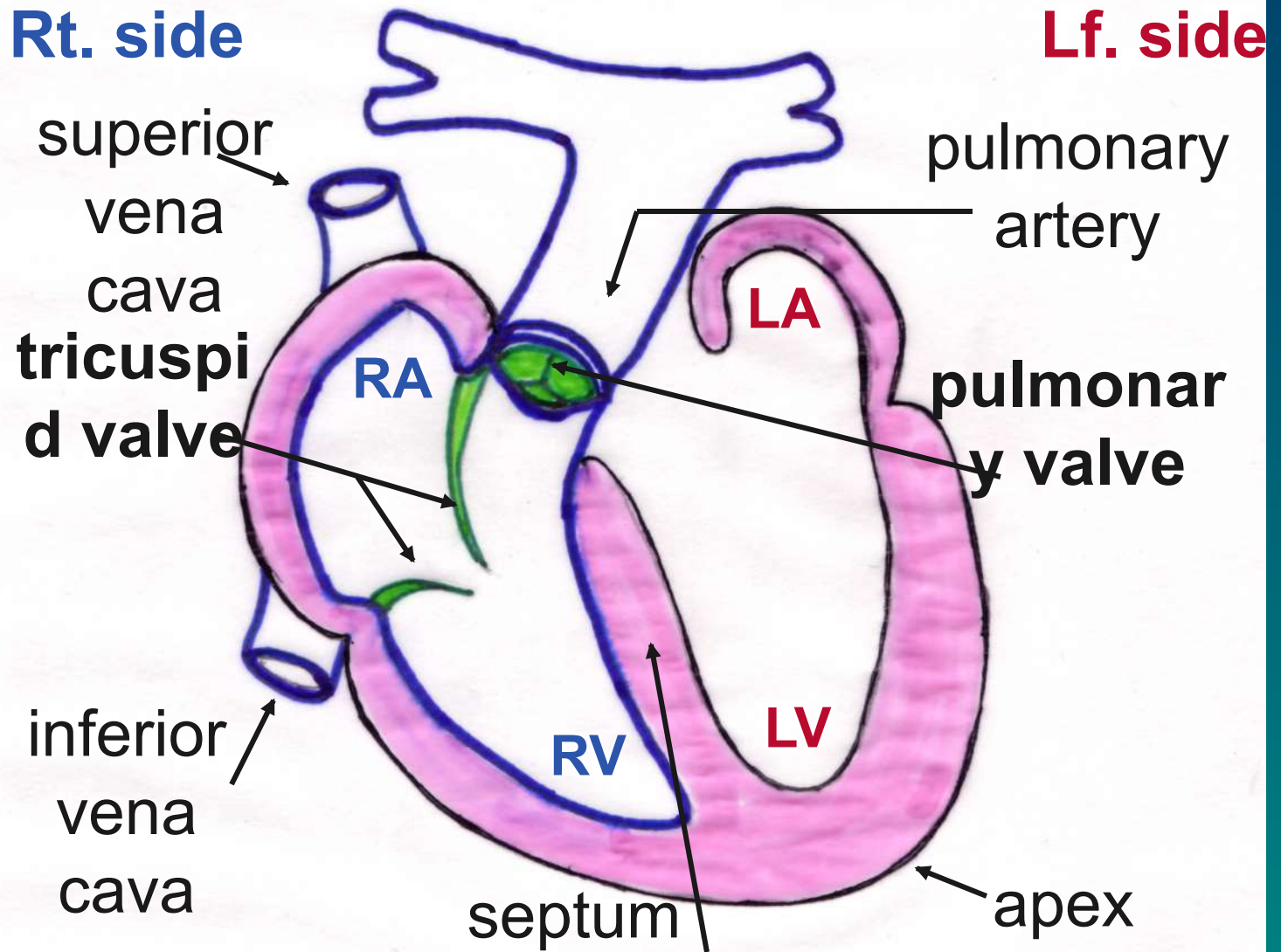
Step 6: Draw pulmonary valve.



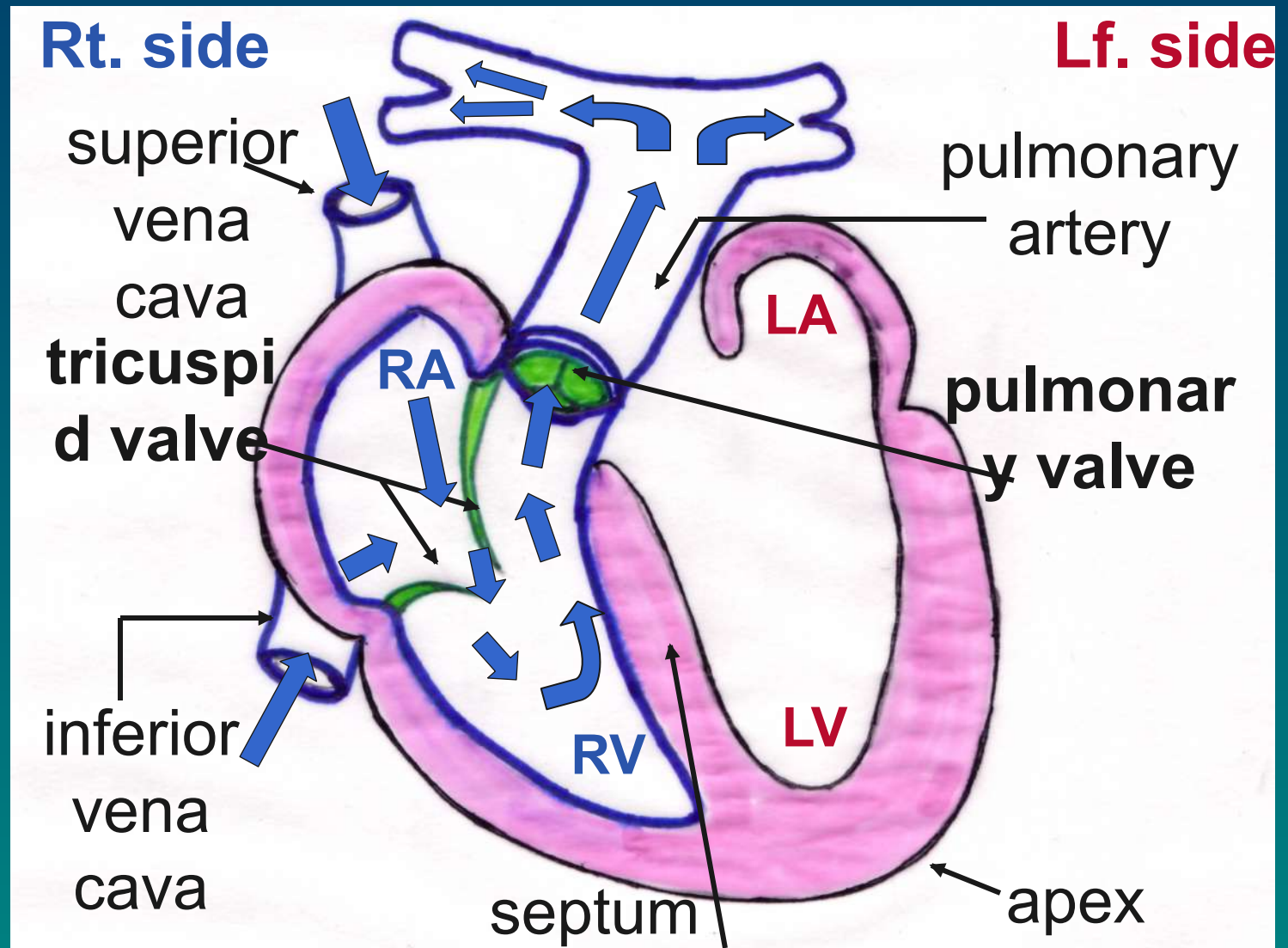
Step 7: Outline great vessels & chambers with blue marker.

Step 9: Indicate pathway of blood through right heart with arrows.

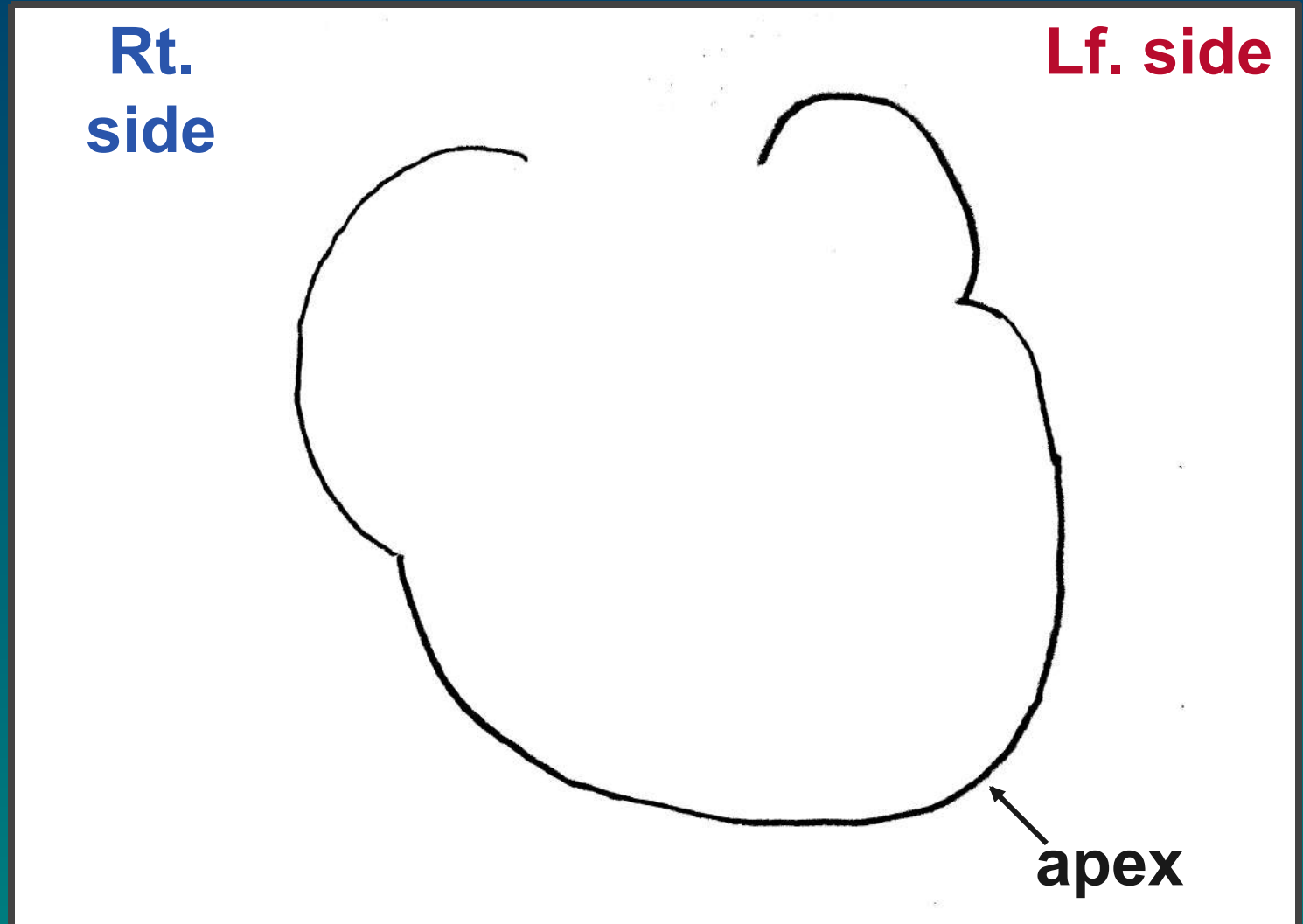

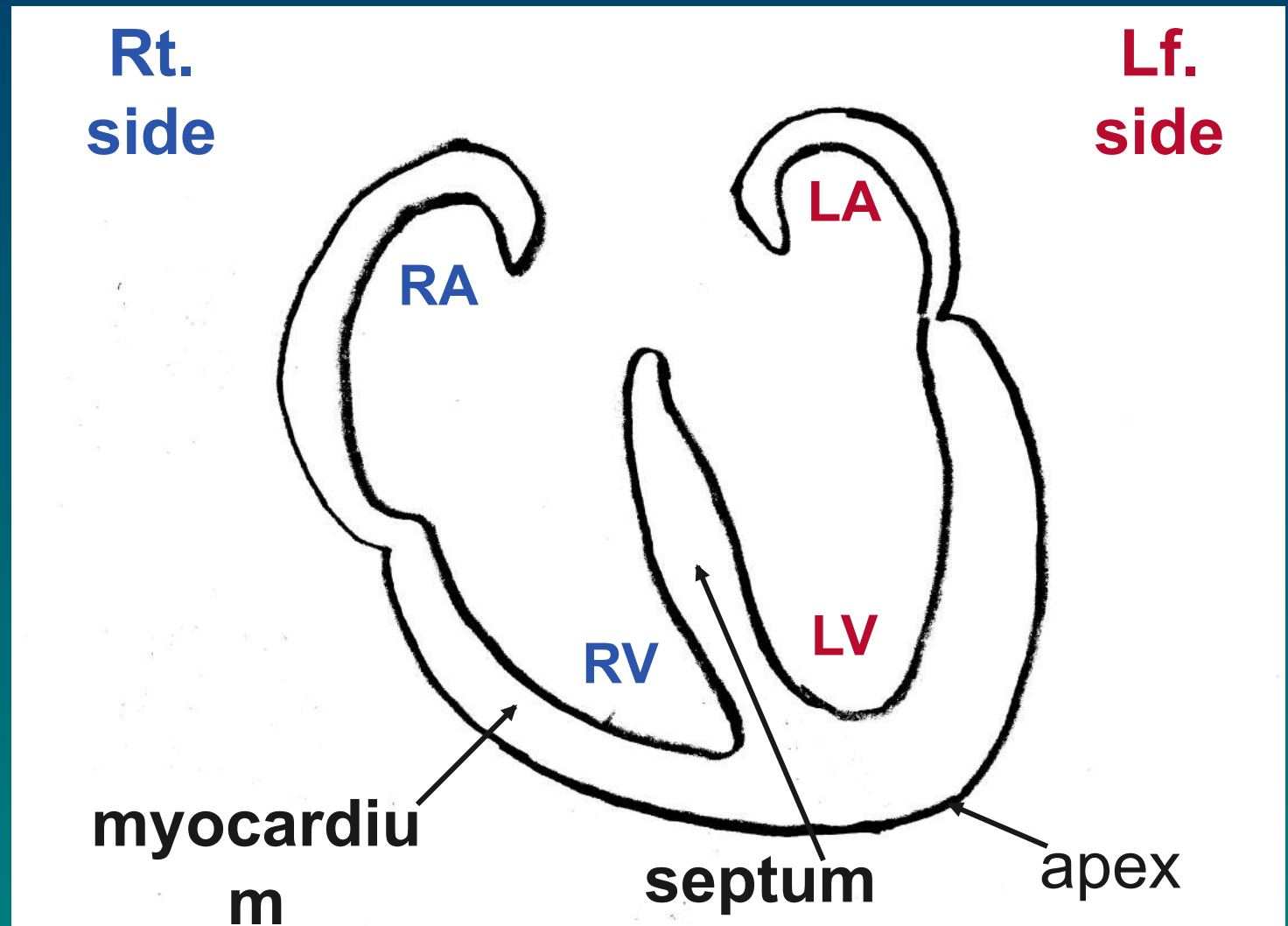

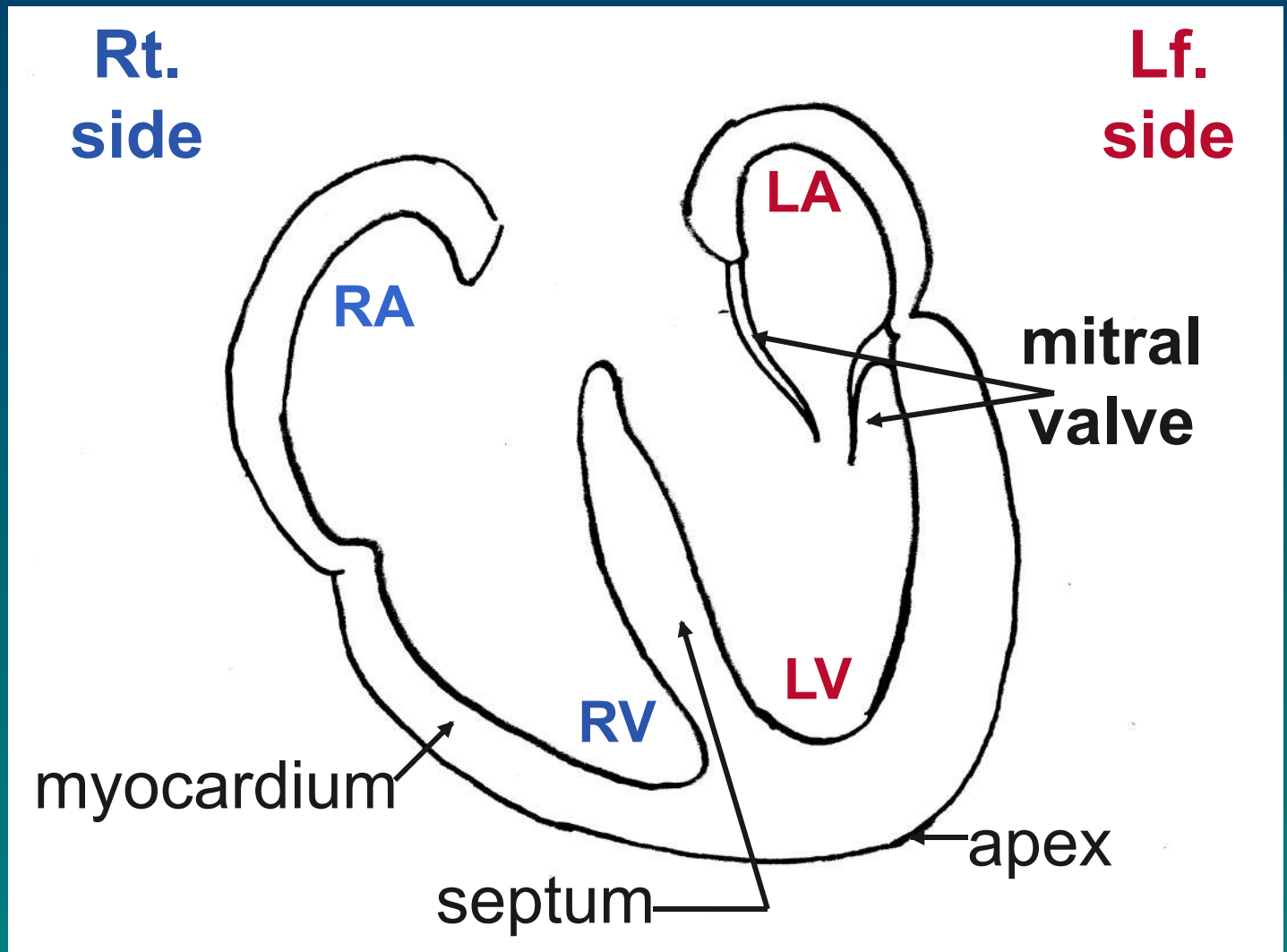
Step 1: Draw outline of heart.



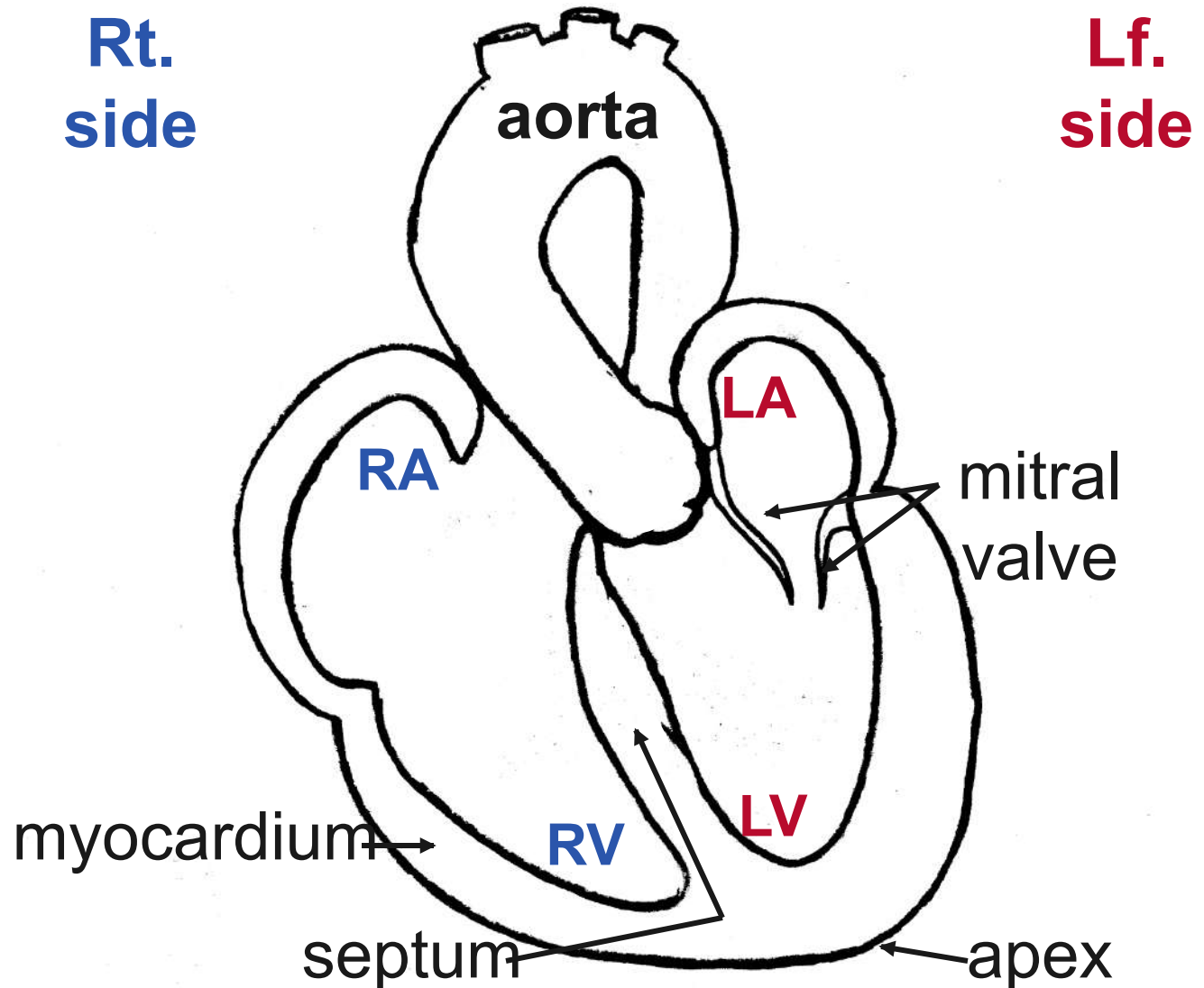
Step 2: Draw the myocardium and septum



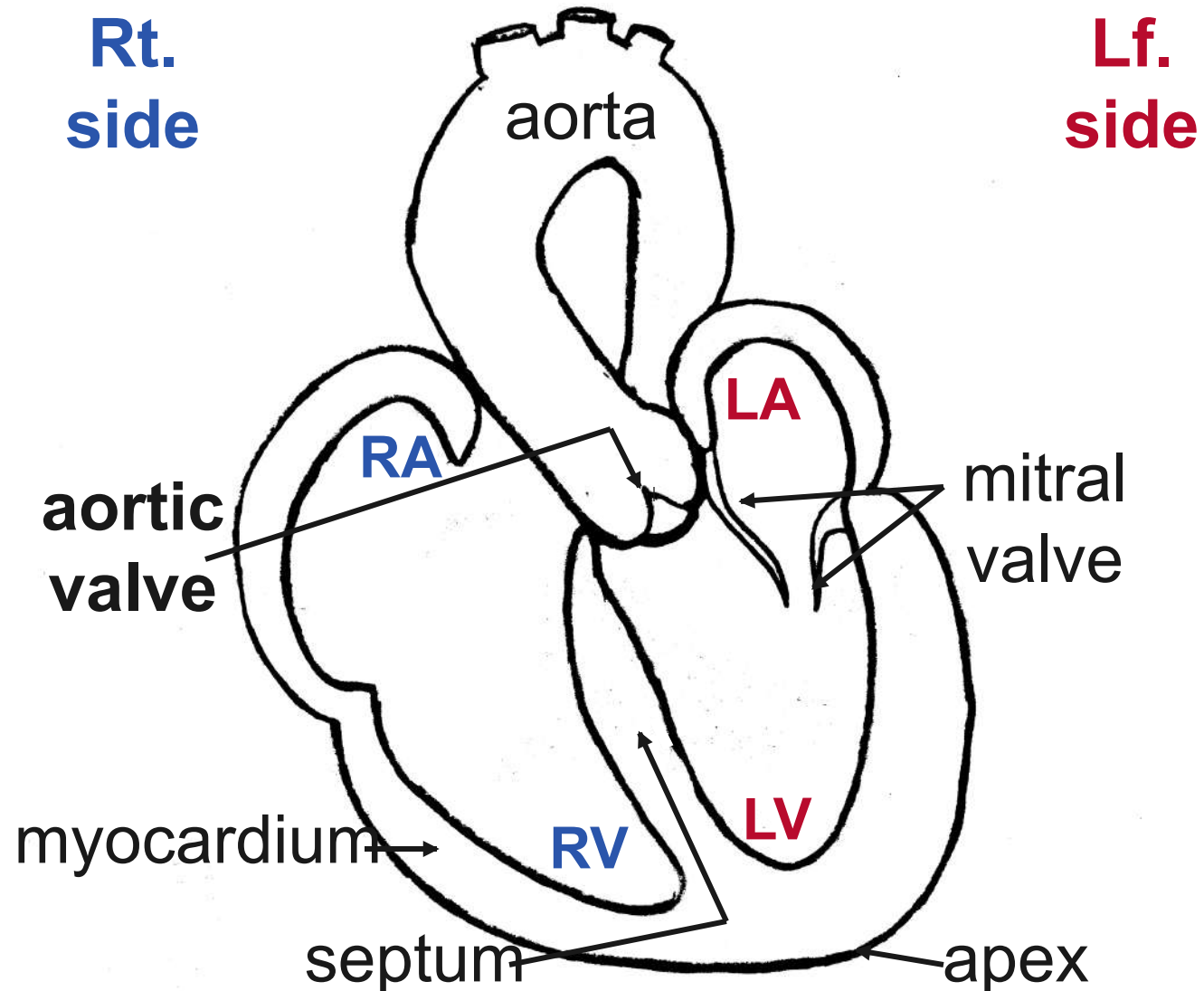
Step 3: Draw mitral valve.



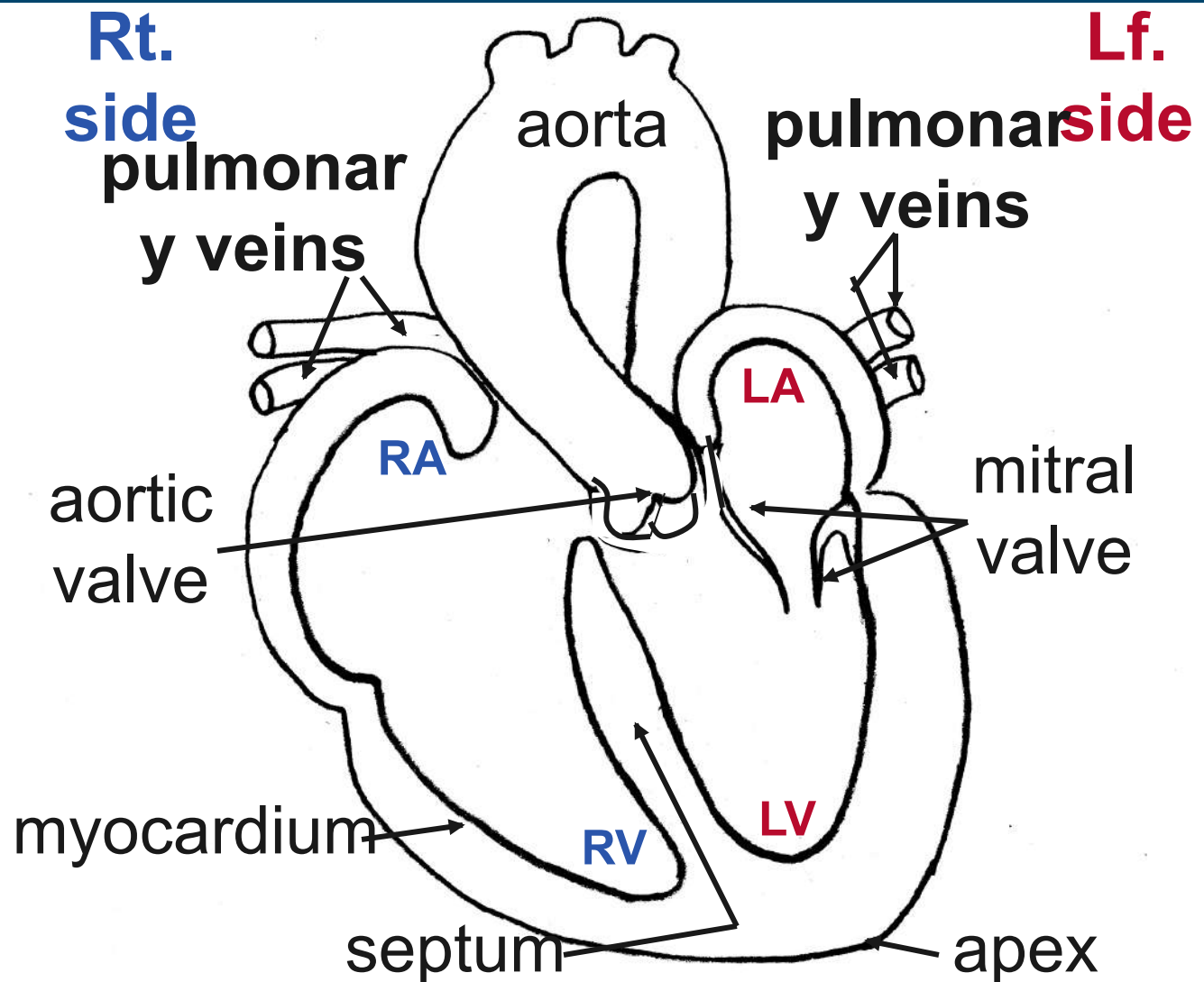
Step 4: Draw aorta.



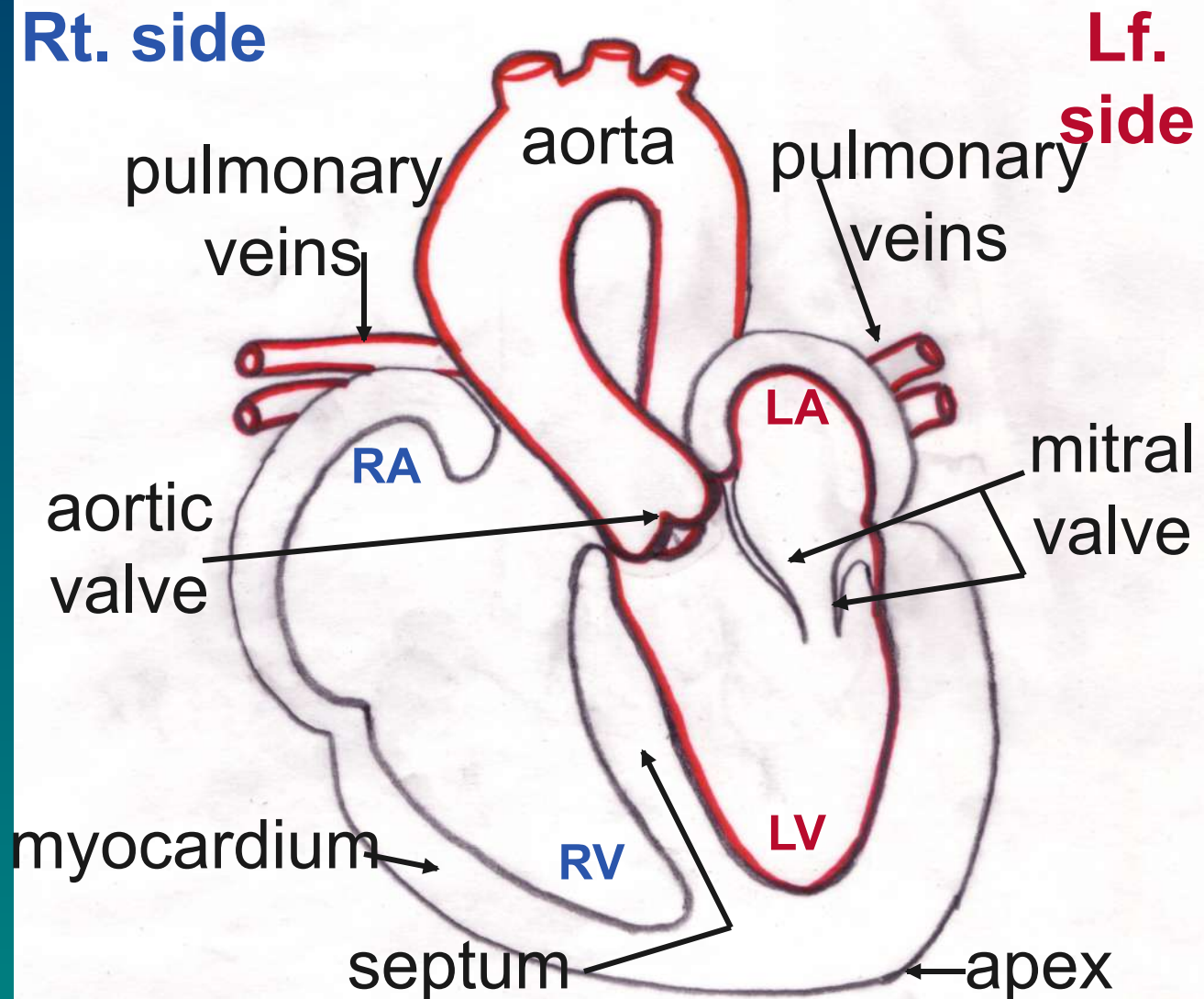
Step 5: Draw aortic valve.



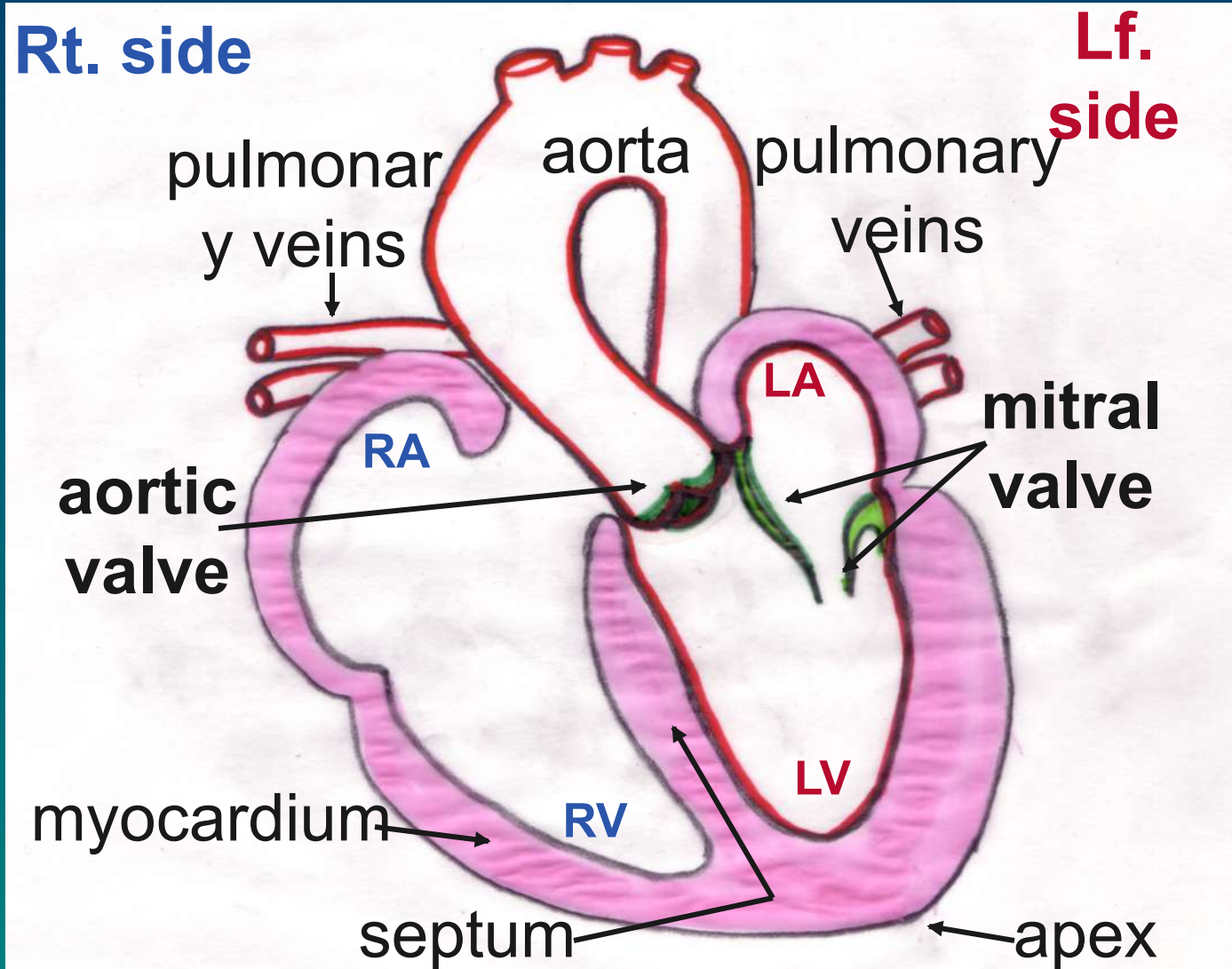
Step 6: Draw pulmonary veins.



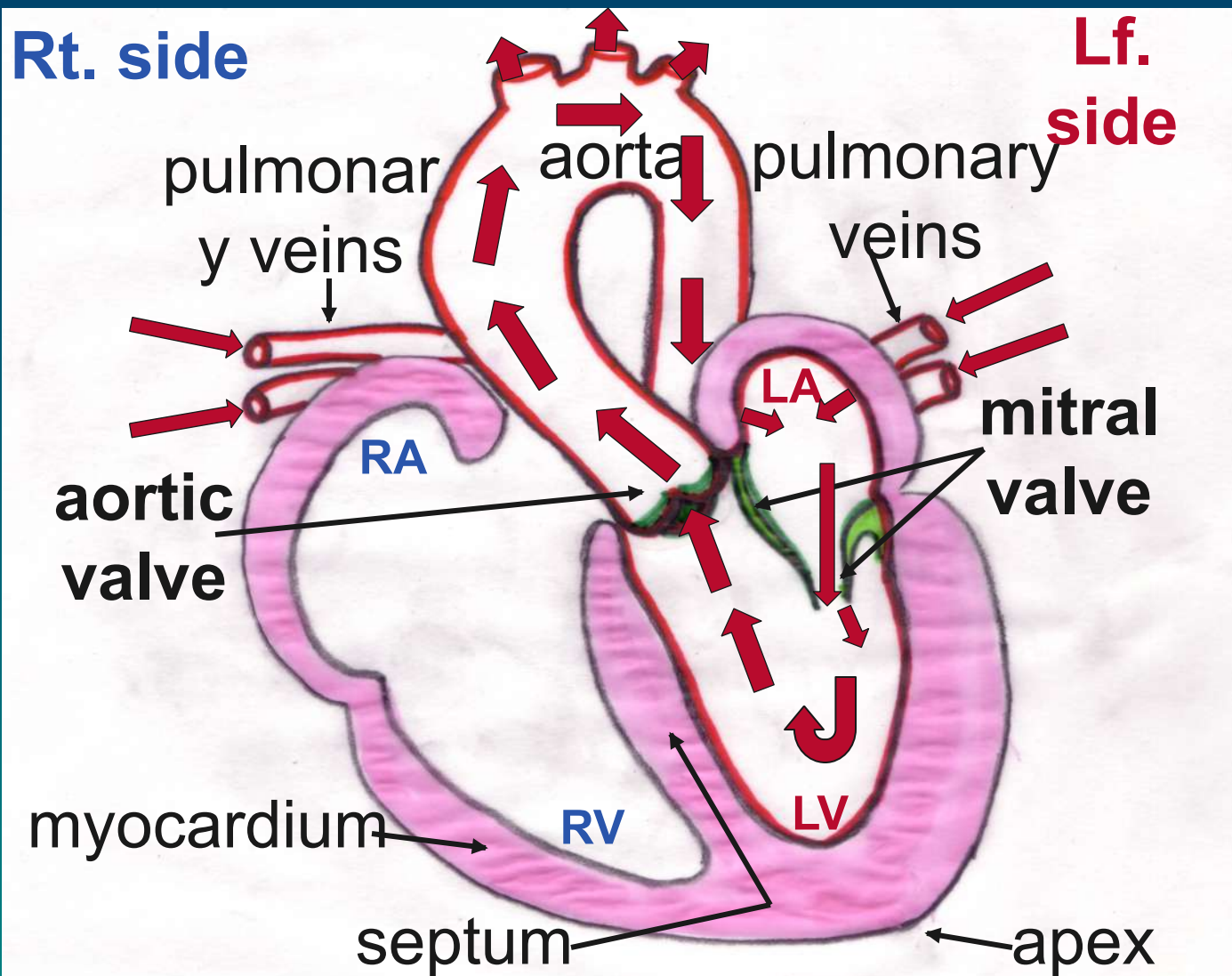
Step 7: Outline great vessels & chambers with red marker.



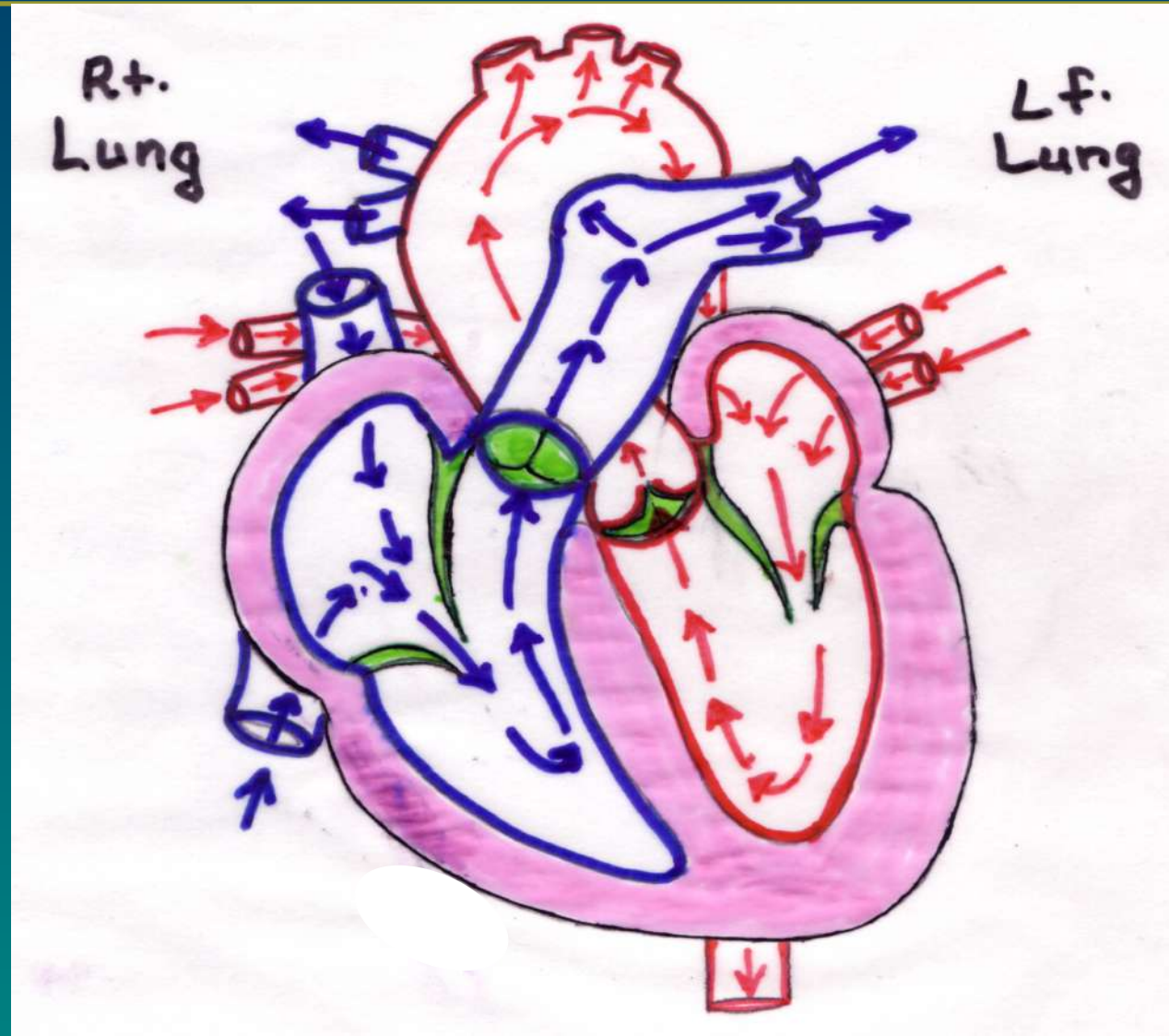
**Step 7: Outline valves in green.
