What is an architect?

An architect is a person who plans and designs buildings. An architect combines art and science to create livable spaces for private and business use. Architects design houses, office buildings, skyscrapers, landscapes, ships, and even entire cities. Sometimes they work in teams for big projects, sometimes they work alone. Most of us think about houses and buildings, however, the space that is created may also give you an "experience". For example, Maya Lin created the design for the Vietnam Memorial In Washington DC. An architect attempts to create a space which reflects the reason for building the space. Architect Frank Lloyd Wright believed in creating structures which were in harmony with the environment and utilizing many of the natural materials from the area it was being built. He called this "organic architecture". The best example of his style is a house called FallingWater which is built partly over a real waterfall!
















Vocabulary:
