

DREAM VACATION

Spring Break is quickly approaching. Many of you may have planned a beach vacation, a travel abroad trip or may just be working for the next 2 weeks. Well, this is YOUR opportunity to plan your DREAM VACATION. You will have an UNLIMITED budget to travel anywhere in the **United States**. Think about where you would go, what you would do, what places would you visit. In this project you will be planning a 7-day/6-night trip anywhere in the United States for you and a friend.

In order to plan this trip you will need to find the following items:

- ★ Airline flights leaving from Philadelphia to your destination. This includes the flight numbers for the trip there and the return trip and the price for a round-trip flight for you and a friend. (**You MUST fly to your destination**)
- ★ A rental car and the rental price for seven days.
- ★ A hotel and the price for the six nights. (You may be planning to drive around and you may stay at more than one hotel).
- ★ Places to go and things to do for the seven days of your vacation (you may need to estimate the cost if you cannot find the exact cost of things).
- ★ Restaurants to eat at and the cost for two people. (estimate)
- ★ The weather for the next 7 days of your chosen location.
- ★ A map of where you are going.

Using this information you will create the following:

1. A 7 day/6 night Itinerary, including a cover sheet – Both done in MS Word
2. A weather forecast done in MS Word
3. A cost sheet showing the breakdown of the cost for the trip for 2 people (Use MS Excel and formulas to create total costs)
4. A brochure describing the vacation location (include attractions, site seeing stops, museums, etc.) – Use MS Publisher
5. A map of your destination (Word)
6. A reference list including all the web sites that were used in this project.

You will turn in a minimum 7 page project (some projects may be more than one page). Staple the project in the order above, **starting with the cover sheet.**


