Drip, Drip, Drop

Materials: several large sponges, 2-3 buckets of water

This game is played a little like duck, duck, goose. The students sit in a big circle. Place the buckets of water in the middle of the circle and place the sponges in the buckets. Choose a few students to go to the center and get a sponge from one of the buckets of water. The student then steps outside of the circle and walks around the circle holding the wet sponge over the kid's heads. While walking, the student will say "Drip, drip, drip" as they pass over people they don't want to select and they will drip a small amount of water on them. When they find the person they really want to soak, they will say "Drop" and squeeze the entire sponge of water on the student. The student will hand the sponge to this person and take his/her space. The student who was drenched now takes the sponge and dunks it in the water and repeats the process.
