## High School Pathways

### Mandarin Immersion

These are suggested pathways and will vary based on student and school schedules, student interest, and availability of courses. Students can take IB courses in Mandarin without being enrolled in the entire IB program. All IB courses are 2-years long. Students who only take year one of an IB course will not be eligible to take the IB exam. Colleges use results from the IB exams to award college credit. All students should register for Mandarin III for 9th grade. Students take a placement test and the AAPPL assessment in spring of 8th grade. Results will be shared with parents and counselors, and summer adjustments to student schedules will be based on the results and student/parent preferences.
