- I. Call to Order
 - o The regular meeting of the District-wide Educational Improvement Council (DWC) was called to order at 4:30 pm on November 14, 2017 by Dr. John Chapman. The agenda for the meeting, October 10th meeting minutes, district calendar, and calendar questions were disseminated.
- II. Consider / Approve the October 10th DWC Meeting Minutes
 - o Motion was made by Judi Tabb, seconded by Talisha Wolfe, to approve the October 10th DWC Meeting Minutes. Motion carried unanimously.
- III. Developing the 2018-2019 School Calendar
 - o Mr. Gilstrap presented questions for the council to discuss and vote on.
 - The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to front load professional development/workdays.
 - The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay for the first day of instruction to be in middle of the week.
 - The council voted 14 yay / 1 nay for Fair Day to be a holiday for both teachers and students.
 - The council voted 10 yay / 5 nay to have an early release day at the end of the first grading period.
 - The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to have an early release day at the end of each semester.

- The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to keep a full week for Thanksgiving break.
- The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to end the semester prior to Winter Break.
- The council voted 13 yay / 2 nay to take the week of Christmas and the week after for Winter Break.
- The council voted 14 yay / 1 nay to have a holiday for teachers and students in February.
- The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to have a professional development day the first day back from Winter Break.
- The council voted 11 yay / 4 nay to end school prior to Memorial Day.
- Other holidays
 1. The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to keep Good Friday as a teacher and student holiday.
 2. 9 council members voted for MLK Day to be a professional development day. 6 council members voted for MLK Day to be a holiday for teachers and students.
 3. The council voted 15 yay / 0 nay to keep Veterans Day as a regular school day.
- Mr. Gilstrap asked the council "What are your top two priorities?"
 1. October & February holidays
 2. To complete the school year for teachers and students in May. (not necessarily prior to Memorial Day)
- Other calendar discussions included:
 1. Consideration of "Meet the Teacher" nights. Teachers are concerned that they do not have enough time to complete their rooms prior to "Meet the Teacher" nights.
 2. "Good Monday" – the council would like to consider a four day weekend. Good Friday – Good Monday.

IV. New Business – the council did not have any new business to discuss.
