Application for Early Graduation
End of the Junior Year**

Application Guidelines

1. The student must have accumulated a minimum of 15 credits and maintained an un-weighted 3.0 GPA by the end of his/her sophomore year.
2. The student must have definite and acceptable purposes and goals for early graduation; i.e., entrance into a post-secondary institution, a full-time job commitment, enlistment into the armed forces.
3. Student must submit two letters of recommendation from current or past teachers indicating the student's ability to complete the rigorous schedule of coursework required for early graduation.
4. Requests to take online courses or courses outside Union County Public Schools must be submitted with this application.
5. The student must have a conference with his/her counselor before the end of the sophomore year and submit a formal application at that time. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
6. The application will be reviewed by a school based committee of administrators, guidance counselors and teachers and a decision made within 30 days of the submission date. The completed application should be forwarded to the Central Services office of the Director of Secondary Education for final approval from the Assistant Superintendent of Instruction within the first 10 days of the first semester of the Junior year. If the application is not approved, the guidance counselor will receive a written explanation to give to the student.
7. It is understood that if the required credits cannot be scheduled as needed or if the student fails to earn the credits necessary, the student will not be able to graduate early.
