

Students & families at **Earl Boyles Elementary School** were surveyed in November 2018 & 2019 about their experiences in school in terms of Engagement, Academic Rigor, Instructional Methods, Relationships, and Culture. We heard from **96%** of students and **13%** of families, and with the help of the nonprofit YouthTruth, analyzed their responses to use for decision-making and improvements. Here are a few things we learned from the survey!



## Family Satisfaction

**92% of Earl Boyles families say they would recommend their school to parents seeking a school for their child.** This is 15 points higher than the state and national averages.

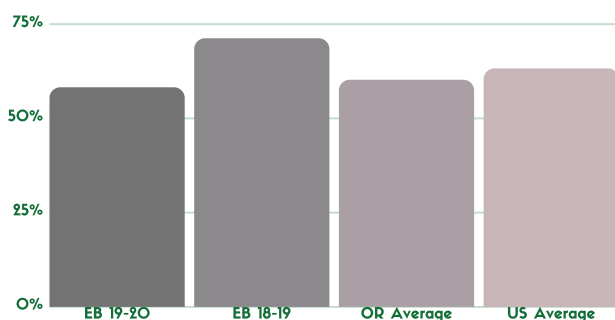
# 87%

of Earl Boyles students feel **their teacher really cares about them**. This is a 8-point increase from last year, 4 points higher than the typical Oregon school, and 6 points higher than the national average.

## What can we do better?

58% of Earl Boyles students say they feel safe in the hallways at school. This is a 13-point decrease from last year, 11 points lower than the average Oregon school, and 5 points lower than the national average.
