■ **Academic Search™ Premier**

Containing indexing and abstracts for over 8,450 journals — with full text for more than 4,650 of those titles — this scholarly collection offers information in nearly every area of academic study, including biology, chemistry, engineering, physics, psychology, religion & theology and more.

■ **Auto Repair Reference Center™**

Containing information on most major manufacturers of domestic and imported vehicles, this database provides information on more than 33,800 vehicles, including drawings and step-by-step photographs, technical service bulletins & recalls, enhanced wiring diagrams, specifications & maintenance schedules, a Labor Time Guide & Estimator and much more.

■ **Business Source® Premier**

Providing full text for more than 2,150 journals dating back as far as 1965, this superior business resource covers all disciplines of business, including marketing, management, MIS, POM, accounting, finance and economics. Additional full-text, non-journal content includes market research reports, industry reports, country reports, company profiles and SWOT analyses.

■ **Career Library™**

This resource provides nearly 550 scholarly full-text journals focusing on many medical disciplines, and offers access to 822 abstracted and indexed journals. Coverage of nursing and allied health is particularly strong.

■ **Library, Information Science & Technology Abstracts™ (LISTA)**

LISTA indexes more than 550 core journals, 50 priority journals and nearly 125 selective journals, plus books, research reports and proceedings. Subject coverage includes librarianship, classification, cataloging, bibliometrics, online information retrieval, information management and more.

■ **Literary Reference Center™**

This full-text database provides users with a broad spectrum of information on thousands of authors and their works across literary disciplines and timeframes, combining information from major respected reference works, books and literary journals, and much more.

■ **MAS Ultra™ – School Edition**

■ EBSCOhost®

More than 300 full-text and secondary databases are available via EBSCOhost. According to *School Library Journal* (August 2008), "EBSCO has not only completely redesigned its interface, it has taken database searching into the 21st century, creating a model certain to motivate change in future databases."

It is this premise that makes EBSCOhost the most-used reference resource around the world. A customizable, intuitive search experience, EBSCOhost is designed to cater to various user needs and preferences at every level of research. EBSCOhost is available 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.

■ Student Research Center™

The *Student Research Center* provides students in secondary schools with the most appropriate research tools for easily obtaining the information that they seek from their EBSCO databases. Through the *Student Research Center*, users can easily pre-determine which content sources (e.g., Magazines, Newspapers, Biographies, Country Reports, Film & Video) will be included with their search. They can also search their databases by topic heading, make use of an online dictionary and encyclopedia, explore the top searches of the day, and even limit their search according to appropriate Lexile reading levels where applicable.

■ Kids Search™

It is an animated interface with a dinosaur theme that encourages students to enhance and develop basic search methodologies. Students will be riveted by the colorful, animated interface, complete with erupting volcanoes and a dinosaur guide, as they gather information on a wide range of topics. *Searchasaurus* offers Lexile limiters (reading level), making it easy for students to read and research only appropriately challenging materials.
