<p>What do students need to do?</p> <p><u>Link to BV instructional video for week of April 20-24, 2020</u></p>	<p>Monday (4/20):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Write random uppercase letters on a piece of paper, including the letters in your child's name, have your child find and circle the letters in their name <p>Tuesday (4/21):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Play, I Spy-put a variety of objects on a tray and then say, "I Spy something ..." <p>Wednesday (4/22):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Write child's name in all capital letters and then have them glue on different colored squares of paper to make a mosaic <p>Thursday (4/23):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read 10 minutes • Write a "thank you" to your mail carrier/garbage man and have your child color a picture to go with it.
