What do students need to do? Link to BV instructional video for week of March 30 - April 3, 2020	Monday (3/30): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Write the names of your family members multiple times on a sheet of paper, have your child find their own name and circle it Tuesday (3/31): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Write the letters of your child's name on pieces of paper and scatter on the floor, turn on music, dance, freeze, then identify the letter nearest you Wednesday (4/1): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● Write 2 sets of the ABCs on paper, keep one set lined up on the floor and hide the other set around your home, have your child find the letters and come back to match them to the set on the floor Thursday (4/2): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Read 10 minutes ● After reading a story talk about the characters and have your child draw their favorite character from the story Friday (4/3): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No assignment
What do students need to bring back to school?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The picture of their favorite character from a story they read ● Send any photos of your child doing these activities to their teacher

Link to BV instructional video for week of March 30 - April 3, 2020	Monday (3/30): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use popsicle sticks, toothpicks, q-tips, or straight pretzels etc. to form basic shapes Tuesday (3/31): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gather items that are the same, but 3 different sizes (small, medium, large) and have your child sort by size, for example use 3 different sized shirts, shoes, pants, etc. Wednesday (4/1): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Write numbers 1-10 on pieces of paper, have your child count objects for each number Thursday (4/2): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Draw large shapes on a piece of paper, have your child name each shape and outline each shape with toys Friday (4/3): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> no assignment
What do students need to bring back to school?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Send any photos of your child doing these activities to their teacher

Tuesday (3/31): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Draw Mat Man- see notes below Wednesday (4/1): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Build a pyramid with cups or blocks Thursday (4/2): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You create a stacked block design with a max of 5 blocks and have your child copy the design with up to 5 blocks Friday (4/3): <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No assignment
