What is the Purpose of ECAC?

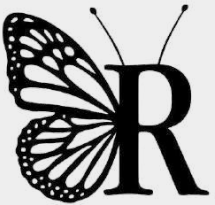
- ✓ Review preschool program implementation of high-quality programs

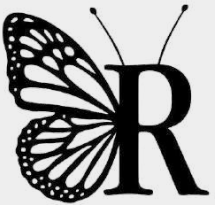

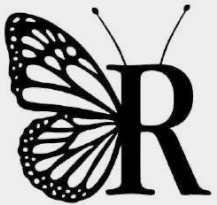

Curriculum®

The Creative Curriculum

The Creative Curriculum is an early childhood curriculum that focuses on project-based investigations as a means for children to apply skills and includes developmentally appropriate goals and objectives for children within four main categories of interest:

Social/Emotional - building relationships and identifying, expressing, and managing emotions

Physical - fine motor skills (small muscles - hands, fingers, wrists) and gross motor skills (large muscles - arms, legs, torso)

Cognitive - inquiry, problem solving, making connections, and critical thinking

Language - communication with others, engaging in conversations, and recognizing various forms of print

The curriculum is designed to foster development of the whole child through teacher-led, small and large group activities centered around 11 interest areas - blocks, dramatic play, toys and games, art, library, discovery, sand and water, music and movement, cooking, computers, and outdoors.

The Creative Curriculum also provides teachers with details on child development, classroom organization, teaching strategies, and engaging families in the learning process.
