### Trimester 1-Week 9 (October 9-13)

**Book:** Encounter by Jane Yolen

**Focus:** Students will identify figurative language and describe how it adds to the tone and visualization of the story. Students will identify the story elements.

### **MONDAY**

**Grammar** (15 minutes): Put the week's mentor sentence on the Smart Board (Jivey page 146). Hand each student a mentor sentence to glue on the next page in their journal (Jivey page 147). Students will complete Day 1. (Directions are in the front of their journal. Use Jivey page 148 for answers.) Discuss similes and metaphors, and have students copy the anchor chart in their journal.

**Spelling (5 minutes):** Introduce spelling words. Discuss the spelling pattern (science). Test Thursday.

**Reading (40 minutes):** Ask students to prepare their journal by writing the title and author of the book in their journal. Show students the book <u>Encounter</u> by Jane Yolen. Have them predict what it is about. Read the story. Have students fill out the story elements in their journal. Discuss text evidence and inferencing. Hand out Jivey page 153 to students and complete with the class. (Use Jivey page 154 for answers.)

**Reading (40 minutes):** Reread <u>Encounter</u> by Jane Yolen. Discuss summarizing a story a story. Hand out Jivey page 155 to students and complete with the class. (Use Jivey page 156 for answers.)

(Use Jivey page 158 for answers.) Have students turn in their journal and write one complete page to the prompt, "Should Christopher Columbus be considered a hero?"
