Dear Students and Parents/Guardians:

Even though the weather still feels like summer, the beginning of the 2018-2019 School Year is right around the corner. This fall brings exciting academic opportunities for our students and faculty! This year we will be offering Senior Project for all of our seniors! Seniors have the opportunity to pursue an externship, research project, or community service project during the fourth quarter. This past school year was our pilot year and we had 115 seniors participate! We are looking forward to having most of our seniors participate in this exciting opportunity this year! Also, starting with the Class of 2021, students have the opportunity to earn a Global Competency Certificate to be issued at graduation if all the requirements are met. There will be a website with all the information for this certificate available in the fall. As part of our continued work around social emotional learning and building an inclusive school community all sophomores and 50 staff members will participate in Challenge Day on October 1st and 2nd. The Challenge Day organization is the world leader in building school communities where students and adults feel safe and connected. Last year we had 100 students and 25 staff members participate in Challenge Day and the impact on our school was positive and transformative. You may have also noticed that we have added the beginnings of a Project Adventure course at TMHS! The course will be implemented into physical education as well as in other content areas. The program allows us to continue the work that the Wynn Middle School has done with Project Adventure for many years. In our continued efforts to keep all of our students safe and informed about the dangers of alcohol and drug use, we will be having a mandatory pre-prom program for all juniors and their parents in late February or early March. Seniors and their parents must attend this pre-prom program only if they did not attend the program last year as a junior. More details concerning the exact date and time for this event will be sent out this fall. We are also excited to have chromebook carts for all teachers who teach Science, Mathematics, English, Social Studies and World Language. Students and teachers will be utilizing the devices to enhance and support teaching and learning. All registration and payments for athletics, clubs and parking must be done through CommunityPass. Enclosed are directions for accessing CommunityPass. Similar to last year, I have scheduled the Admin Chats for parents/guardians throughout the course of the year and informal sessions for parents to come and meet with me. The chats will have a content focus. I have asked the department head/lead teacher for each major content area to be at the Admin Chat to answer any questions you might have. I hope that you will be able to attend one of the chats so that we can have the opportunity to hear your thoughts and ideas. I also encourage students to set up an appointment with me or just stop by my office to share an idea or thought.

Please join me in welcoming the following new faculty and staff to TMHS: Ms. Margaret Murray will be joining our CTBE Department as a Computer Technology teacher. Mr. Dylan Malynn will be joining our Science Department as a Physics teacher. Mr. Joel Mignault will be one of three new teachers in our Wellness Department. Ms. Brooke Pacheco is also joining our Wellness Department. And the third newest teacher of the Wellness Department is not new to us at TMHS, Mr. Steve Kasprzak will be teaching Physical Education and Health as well. Our library will have a new face greeting students as they walk in, Mr. Jay Zimmerman will be our new Library/Media specialist. Ms. Maura Pilotte will be joining our Special Education Department as a school adjustment counselor. Ms. Charlotte Brace, Ms. Meredith Fahey, and Mr. Dillon McTiernan will be our new classroom instructional aides. Ms. Elaine Walsh, R.N. from the Heath Brook School will be joining us as an additional nurse in our building who will also be teaching and running our CNA program this year.

Also, Ms. Julia Fabiano will be our new lead teacher for our Wellness Department and Ms. Jessica Simpson will be our new lead teacher for our CTBE Department.

The Common App Kick-off is an opportunity for our seniors to get a head start on the college application process! The common application is the application that most colleges and universities across the nation use for their admission process. The application is all done electronically and becomes available to students on August 1, 2018. Guidance counselors will be available to provide help and advice on the college essay and the common app. Students should have access to their social security number, resume with activities, parents/guardians contact information, parent's occupation and education level in order to complete the application. It is recommended that all sophomores and juniors participate in the PSAT exam. Junior students who excel at PSAT exam may qualify for the National Scholarship Program. This exam gives our sophomores and juniors practice with the type of questions on the new SAT exam. It also gives the students feedback on their strengths and specifically what Advanced Placement courses they should consider taking.

Junior parents are invited to attend a parent breakfast for an informative post-graduate planning presentation co-presented with Guidance and MEFA staff members. All junior students will attend an informational assembly on post-graduate planning.

Extra-Curricular Activities:

It is important for students to feel connected to their school. When students are connected by being involved in clubs, activities and athletics they are often more successful in the classroom. I challenge all of our students to join at least one club, activity, and/or athletic team at TMHS. Bring your friends along and make many new ones in the process! The cost for all clubs is \$50 for one and \$100 for unlimited club participation. The cost for participation on one athletic team is \$150 and a family cap of \$600 for the school year. This year **all students participating in athletics or in a club must register at CommunityPass. You may also pay the user fee online through CommunityPass at <https://register.communitypass.net> with a credit card or using your checking account. Students will not be allowed to try out for a sport or participate in a club until the fee has been paid. You will be able to log in to CommunityPass on August 13th to pay.** All Tewksbury families have an account with CommunityPass. You received an email in April with your username and login. Please reference the enclosed directions for logging into CommunityPass.

Student Parking:

Parking spaces are only for senior and junior students. If you wish to obtain a parking permit (and meet the set requirements), you will be issued a pass. The cost this school year for a parking permit is \$150. All students must first register for a parking permit through CommunityPass at <https://register.communitypass.net>. You can pay the fee with a credit card or using your checking account through CommunityPass. You will be able to register and pay as of August 13th. See the insert with directions on logging into CommunityPass. After a student has registered for parking on CommunityPass the student should report to the TMHS office on **Thursday, August 23rd with a Xerox copy of their license and a Xerox copy of their registration. Seniors should report from 9:00 am to 11:00 am and Juniors from noon to 2:00 pm to pick up their parking pass.**
