4. The NRHEG PTO will be installing concrete to connect our current sidewalks to the playground equipment. This will greatly assist the students in getting from one set of equipment to the other when the ground is wet or muddy. They will also be installing trees near the Buddy Benches.
5. Beginning with the fall of 2017, in collaboration with Mr. Paula and a few high school students, we will be able to provide an opportunity for our students that haven't been made available since the elementary sites came together in 2009. The Elementary Tutoring concept will return. Three to four secondary students will begin their day in Ellendale and will be assigned to elementary classrooms where they will be working directly with students needing additional academic support. Secondary students will spend the first hour at the elementary and will then return to their school.
6. We are currently working with staff at Sequoia to finalize the details on Millie's Garden, which will be located under our NRHEG Elementary School sign. Staff collected monies to be used to create this living garden in honor of long-time elementary custodian Millie Paulson.
