
She is best known for politically charged prints about African American life in the 1960's and 70's.


She is a versatile artist who made sculptures, prints and paintings

She was a high school teacher in North Carolina for a short time but quit because salaries for black teachers were so low.


In 1947 she married a Mexican artist, moved to Mexico and became a Mexican citizen

















































This sculpture is of her grand daughter as a child who went on to become the winner of America's Next Top Model Season 4.
