Journal Prompts:

 - c. The first page
- 2. Add 2-3 paragraphs (or a passage of dialogue) to the ending to demonstrate your understanding of the direction the story was going/went.
- 3. Discuss the climax or a pivotal moment and how it changed or shaped the direction of the story.
- 4. Extract a quote from the story, cite it correctly using MLA format, react to it by either
 - a. Discussing how it impacted the story
 - b. Discussing how it indirectly characterized an individual
 - c. Discussing a similar experience you had or how you are able to relate to it
 - d. Discussing why the quote stuck out to you
- 5. Assess the art piece each story is connected with. Decide if it was a good pairing. What elements of the art are seen within the text? Draw connections.
