Find/research a **commercial**. Recreate it using the same shots, audio, and props. Edit it the same way as well! I would do a 30-second commercial.

Try recreating a funny video you might've found on Vine or Tik Tok using **PowerDirector**, or a video editing app you feel comfortable with. (Keep it fun, but clean!)

Create a poster of your favorite band or singer using Photoshop or **Canva**. Add text to it as though there is a concert coming up soon! Location. Time. Date.

Record your pets doing 3 different activities, then do a voiceover of their internal monologue in a fun voice. Use **whatever** video editing software you'd like.

Using InShot, create a Top 5/10 "WatchMojo" style list. A tutorial will be provided!

Walk around your house or in school and randomly interview people to get their reactions. You can use questions like: What's your favorite Delphi restaurant? or What's 7 x 9? Who's your favorite teacher? Why? What's the best thing to eat in our cafeteria. But make sure the questions are asked as fast as possible for the best reaction.
