

HTHS Credit Flexibility

Option B—English Department Performance Standards

English 9 and English 10 = 80 percent

English 11 and English 12 courses at Hamilton Township High School are aligned with the ACT — a collaborating partner cited in Ohio Department of Education's "New Emphasis on Learning" report. The performance standards that follow ensure that a student consistently has demonstrated the tools, applicable knowledge, and understanding to earn Option B credit.

English 11

The student must score a minimum score of 27 on the English section and a score of 8 on the Writing section on an ACT examination. Scaled grade equivalents appear on page two of this document.

English 12

Having first earned credit for English 11, the student must score a minimum of 27 on the Reading section and a score of 9 on the Writing section of the ACT. Scaled grade equivalents appear on page two of this document.

To earn AP Literature & Composition credit, a student must score 36 on the Reading section and at least a 9 on the Writing section and agree to an independent study program with a cooperating teacher to prepare for and take the AP Literature & Composition exam.
