Enlightenment Radio Talk Show

The discoveries of the scientific revolution paved the path for enlightenment thinkers to approach societal questions form a variety of vantages. As we've discussed in class, many philosophes played integral roles during the enlightenment period and subsequently impacted all realms of society. Many of the issues discussed in Paris salons during the 18th century remain pressing issues today.

For this assignment, we will create a radio talk show to discuss a number of questions asked by philosophes during the 18th century. You will be assigned a specific enlightenment thinker and through dialogue, *present their views and ideologies as they would have during the enlightenment period.*

TASK:

- 1. Learn about one figure of the Enlightenment period in detail based off of your assigned role (see list below)
 - a. Find information about your Enlightenment figure from your textbook and at least 3 sources (recommended sources are below)
 - i. Identify the date and place in which he or she lived
 - ii. His/Her primary role in the Enlightenment or Scientific Revolution
 - iii. Information on his or her views on the following seven topics (you may not find information on all topics for each figure):
 - 1. Government
 - 2. Economics
 - 3. Religion
 - 4. Women
 - 5. Education and child rearing
 - 6. War and the military
 - 7. Crime

- The Internet Encyclopedia of Philosophy
- Modern History Sourcebook
- Stanford Encyclopedia of Philosophy

This information should be put on notecards, with one for the biographical material and one for each individual topic. The notecards may be used for reference during the talk show and WILL BE COLLECTED at the conclusion of the debate.

- 2. On the day of the talk show, students will bring in a name card with the following:
 - Their Enlightenment figure's name
 - Words or images that demonstrate an important aspect of the individual's work (it may be a single word, quote, or image).

ASSESSMENT:

Your grade for this assignment will be derived from your preparation materials (notecards) and your participation (responses) to the questions posed in the radio talk show. Additionally, you may dress up as your enlightenment figure to add a degree of authenticity to the activity.

***It is important that you develop your thoughts and responses according to the views of your enlightenment figures during the 18th century.
