The goal of the district's Bilingual class is to help your child learn English and meet age-appropriate English language standards and New Jersey Core Curriculum Content standards. Although you may request to have your child removed from the Bilingual class, students normally participate for a period of three to four years. Multiple criteria are used in making determinations regarding when a student no longer needs program services.

Teacher recommendation
