## Specific Duties of an ESL Teacher

- 1. Work with individual students or small groups of students to reinforce learning of material or skills initially introduced by teachers.
- 2. Assist the teacher in devising special strategies for reinforcing material or skills based on an understanding of individual students, their needs, interests, and abilities; create and modify materials to match students' English proficiency levels.
- 4. Operate and care for equipment used in the classroom for instructional purposes. Help students master equipment used in the classroom.
- 5. Monitor student behavior and help maintain discipline in the classroom; record time out and in-class suspensions.
- 6. Constantly monitor the safety and well-being of students; monitor student attitudes and encourage self-esteem; notify the ESL teacher of any specific concerns.
- 7. Administer initial English Language Proficiency [ELP] tests county-wide to students from K-
- 12, in addition to initial and annual ELP tests to pre-K students, as assigned. 7/23/2013
- 8. Assist students with limited English proficiency in understanding academic language, content, instructions, and expectations, under the direction of an ESL specialist.
- 9. Perform various clerical duties as needed, maintain records of student progress; develop and file incident reports; grade student papers; check daily attendance; make copies; develop classroom displays and instructional material; maintain and operate audiovisual equipment; maintain class files.

- 10. Maintain the same high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality of information about students as is expected of teachers.
