**Timeline of Major Events**

May 1789: Estates General convened

June 1789: Tennis Court Oath  
National Assembly created

July 14, 1789: storming of the Bastille

Jul-Aug 1789: Great Fear

August 1789: Declaration of the Rights of Man

October 1789: "Womens' March:" Louis forced to Tuileries palace  
Jacobin Club formed

July 1790: Civil Constitution of the Clergy

June 1791: "Flight to Varennes"

Sept 1791: new constitution adopted and signed by King Louis XVI

October 1791: Legislative Assembly created

March 1792: guillotine becomes official method of execution

April 1792: France declares war against Austria.

Sept 1792: The September Massacres  
National Convention established

January 1793: King Louis XVI is executed

April 1793: Committee of Public Safety formed

July 1793: Jean-Paul Marat assassinated

Sept 1793: The Reign of Terror begins  
The Law of Suspects is decreed

October 1793: Marie Antoinette executed

July 27 1794: Robespierre executed  
Reign of Terror ends

Nov 1795: The Directory is formed

Nov 1799: Napoleon overthrows the Directory and establishes the French Consulate with himself as leader of France  
(end to the French Revolution)
