Exam Attendance Policy

By board policy, the following criteria must be met to be exempt from a non-EOC, non-CTE Post Assessments.

- Students may be exempted from final course exams if they have five (5) unexcused absences or less with a course average of 90 or above.
- See individual teacher for clarification
- An absence is an absence

NO exemptions allowed in EOC courses and CTE Courses.

Teachers will notify students of exam exemption eligibility.

Students may not sign out during any exam period. All students must remain in the class for the entirety of the exam.

STUDENTS MUST REPORT TO CAMPUS FOR EOC, CTE EXAMS and TEACHER MADE EXAMS. Dismissal and lunch times will vary depending on exam completion. Thank you for your patience.
