- 7)In 2 to 3 sentences, explain why the information/skills that you are learning about in class is/are important to you.
- 8)Discuss 1 way today's lesson could be used in the "real world."
- 9) How could what you learned today make you a better person or a better friend?
- 10) How would you explain today's class to someone who couldn't see or hear?
- 11) Summarize today's lesson in approximately 25 carefully chosen words.

- 12) What is the one of most important things that you learned about today? Please explain.
- 13) Of the strategies/skills/lessons that you learned today, which one do you find to be the most useful? Please explain.
- 14) What is the most interesting idea/thing that you got from today's class? Please explain.
- 15) Explain how the things you learned/discussed today relate to your own life.
- 16) What connection did you make today that made you say to yourself, "AHA! I finally get it!"
- 17) What was the best part of today's class/ lesson?
- 18) Did working with a partner today make your task(s) easier or harder? Please explain.
- 19) Describe three things that you could have done to make today's class a better experience (for you and/or others).

- 21) What is something that really helped you in your learning today?

- 22) Write a question that you'd like to ask regarding what you are now learning about.
- 23) What do you need more help with?
