| S | Satisfactory: Consistently meets expectations | |

S - Satisfactory: Consistently meets expectations

A student who routinely meets grade level standards. Skills are applied independently or with minimal assistance. This level of achievement is developmentally appropriate.

P - Progressing: Progressing toward expectations

This means the student is progressing toward grade level standards. Performance varies in consistency with regard to accuracy and quality. Additional practice and support in school and at home may be necessary.

NI - Needs Improvement: Not yet meeting expectations

This means the student is not meeting grade level standards at the present time. Performance is characterized by limited application of skills and strategies. Student requires considerable support and direction. Additional instruction, practice and support is required to move toward grade level goals.

NTY - Not Taught Yet
