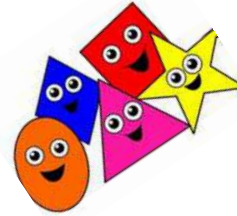

- 4 years old by Dec. 1
- 5 days a week—following school district calendar
- Native language instruction for Spanish & Russian
 - *AM— 8:00—11:00
 - *PM—10:30—1:30
- Half day program with lunch
- Class sizes of 20-24 students
- No Transportation
- **Affordable Pricing:**



- *FREE to Gervais School District residents
- *Non-residents—\$200 a month
- *Scholarships available

SERVICE MODEL

- Ages 6 weeks—Kindergarten
- Teen parents, staff, community
- Latchkey for pre-school students
- Career Technical Lab for Early Childhood Development Strand
- Extended hours 6:30am to 6:30pm
- **Affordable pricing:**
 - *8 1/2 hours or less = \$550 a month
 - *8 1/2 hours or more = \$650 a month
 - * Family rate = full price for 1 child and an additional \$300 for each additional child.
 - * Latchkey for pre-school \$2.50 an hour
 - * No transportation
