Criteria for Monroe County  
Homemaker Scholarship

High School Senior who desires to further their education at an institute of higher learning.  
(College, University or Vocational school).

1. Must be an Extension Homemaker member or the child/grandchild of an Extension Homemaker member of an organized club for at least two years.
2. 3.0 or better GPA on 4.0 scale
3. Must exhibit strong leadership in school and community organizations.
4. Must complete application.
5. Must graduate from high school in the year application is made
6. Return application to the high school guidance counselor.
7. Deadline for application will be the last Friday in April by the end of the school day.
8. An alternate will be chosen in the event of the recipient not fulfilling scholarship requirements.
9. Must enroll in an institution of higher learning in the fall of graduation year. \$500 check will be presented after enrollment.
10. Proof of enrollment must be presented to the Monroe County FCS Agent before the check will be issued.
