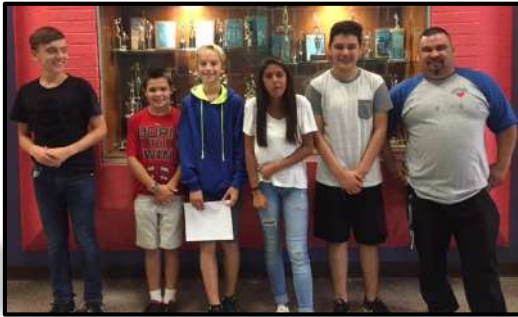
Flu Shot Clinic Dates and Locations
