What is a fact?

A **FACT** can be proven to be true.

If you can find proof, or evidence for a sentence, then it is a **FACT**.

What is an opinion?

An **OPINION** tells what someone thinks or feels. It cannot be proven **true** or **false**.

It often contains words that make judgments... Examples: interesting, beautiful, etc.



A habitat is an environment in which a living thing, such as an animal grows and thrives.






Everyone is <u>enthusiastic</u> to learn about animals and the environments that they live in.


