Facts Statements that can be proven.

(through observation, experience or research)

Facts about Facts

- Give specific information
- Definite statements.
- Often contain numbers,
 dates, or ages

Fact Clue Words

Research, proven, authentic, etc.

FACTS CAN BE TRUE OR FALSE BUT MUST BE ABLE TO BE PROVEN!

Examples of Facts,

- 1. Statistically, women live longer than men.
- 2. Most buses weigh more than most cars.
 - 3. There are ten inches in a foot. (false)

Opinions Statements that cannot be

proven.

Facts about Opinions

- Opinions are judgements
- They tell what people think, feel, or believe

Opinion Clue Words

Believe, feel, think, most, best, should, worst, etc.

- 2. Pizza is delicious.
