Summary of Questions

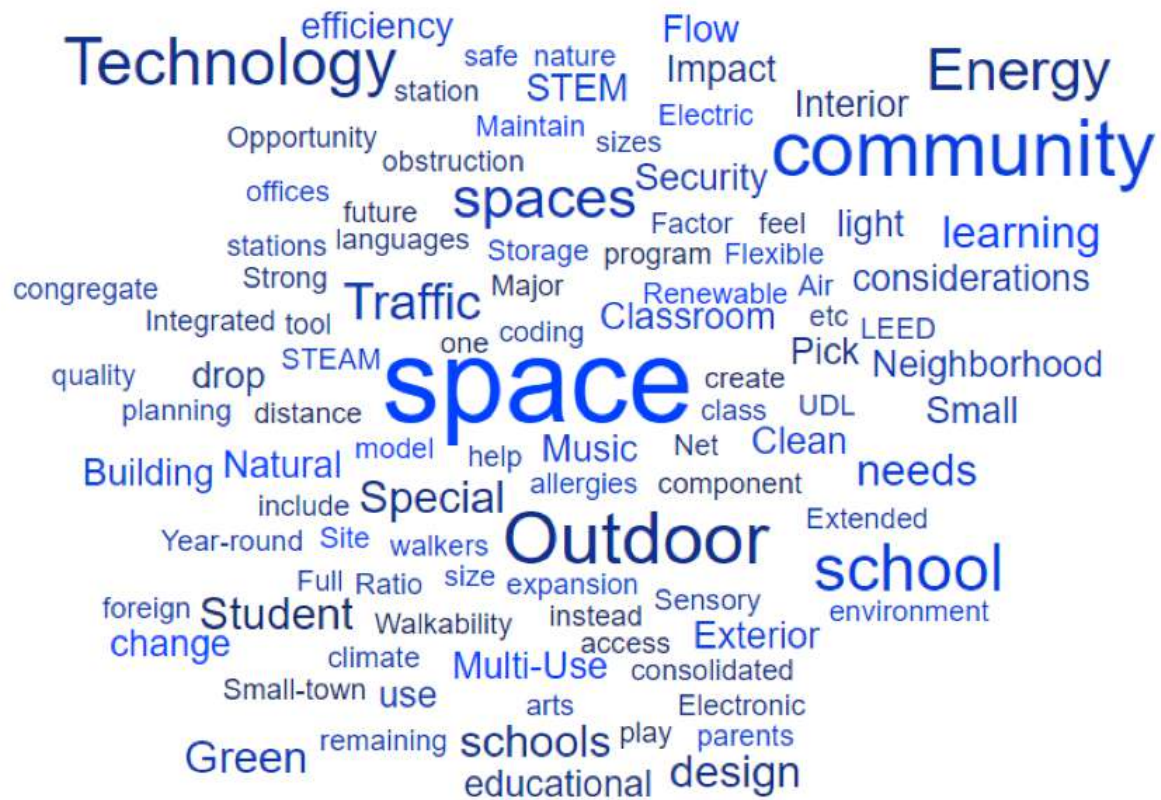
- What happens to school buildings and sites that remaining

- Not enough money to do all of the projects

Summary

- A community that was listened to / Community ideas that were valued
- Involves all people/stakeholders – community members, teachers, parents, administration
- Good communication with parents and community throughout the process
- A cost-efficient project without such a strong monetary impact on the community
- A process that doesn't have a pre-determined outcome / ORGANIC
- Equality of schools after build out/ Consider the individual needs of every elementary school
- Strong research that back up decision making
- On time, on budget, meets expectations
- Consideration of lessons learned from previous projects (visiting other newly built schools)
