Introduction

- Introductions briefly tell the reader what you will be writing about in an interesting way.
- Your introduction may go something like this:

George Washington was a true American hero. He dedicated his life to helping create a new nation and proudly serving his country. George Washington became a military general, and he was the first president of the United States.

Main Ideas

- Each main idea will be a new body paragraph. These ideas should come from the reading that you have done.
- For example, if your topic is George Washington, and your main question is, "Why is George Washington so important to America?" some main ideas might be, "George Washington was a military general," and "George Washington was the first president of the United States."
- These main ideas are your "boxes." Each box will be the topic sentence of a body paragraph.

Supporting Details

• After you have determined the main ideas, you will need to research supporting information for each idea. These are your "bullets."

George Washington was a military general

- George Washington assumed the role of commander of the Continental Army in July, 1775
- He led the attack on the Hessians encamped in New Jersey on Christmas night in 1776
- Washington defeated General Cornwallis, commander of the British army, at the Battle of Yorktown on October 19, 1781
